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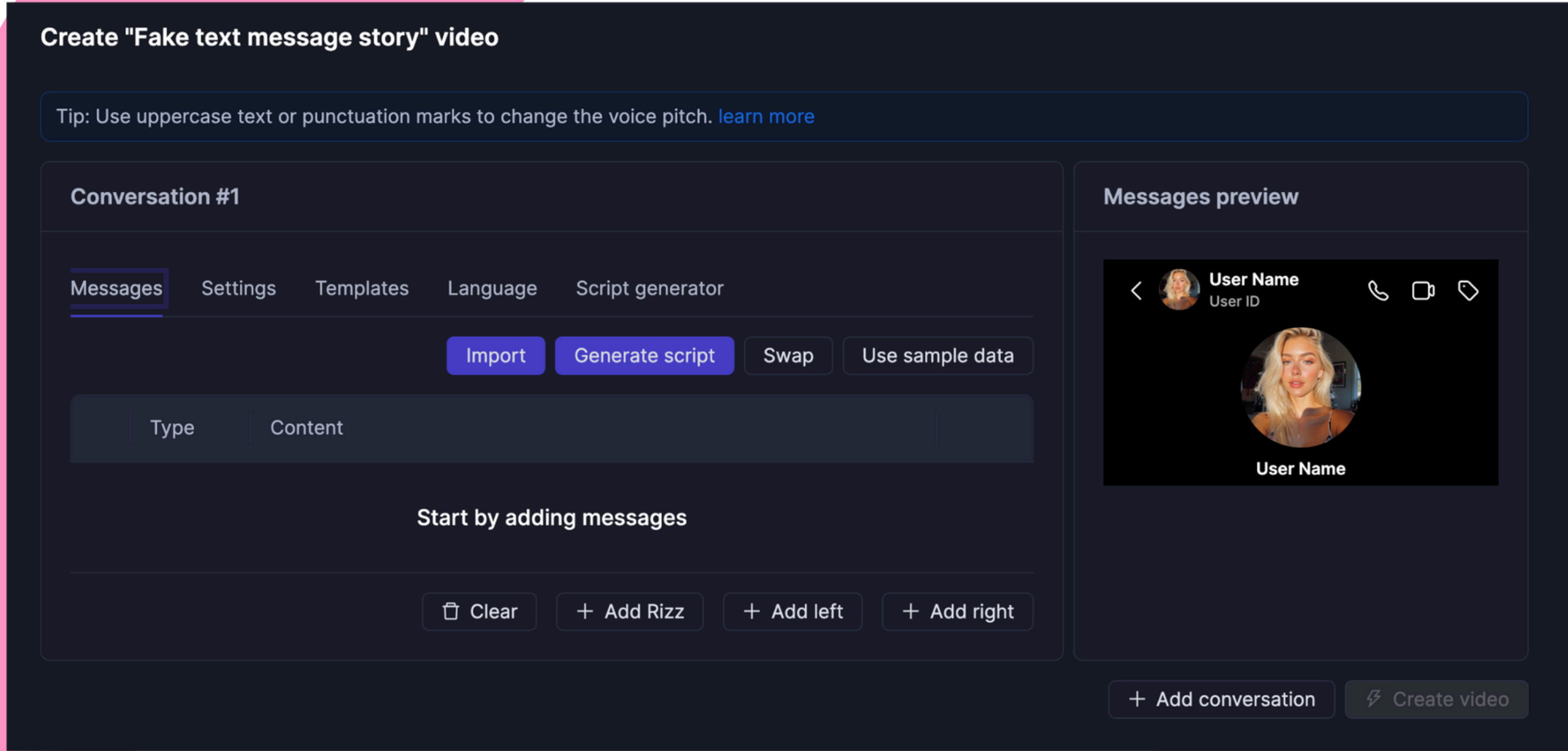
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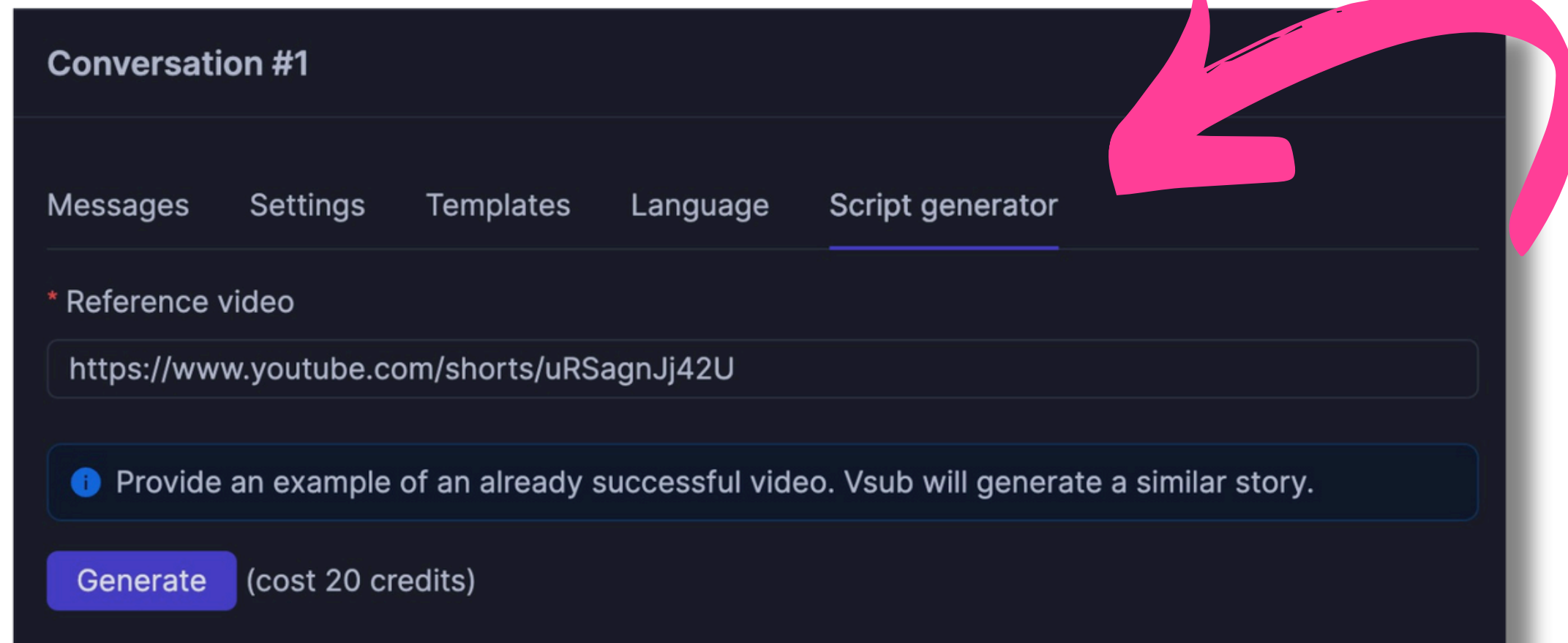

1. CREATION

SCRIPT GENERATOR

This is the fifth tab, but the script is the foundation of the video, so if you don't have it, you can use **the Script Generator**. If you already have the script, you can skip these two slides.

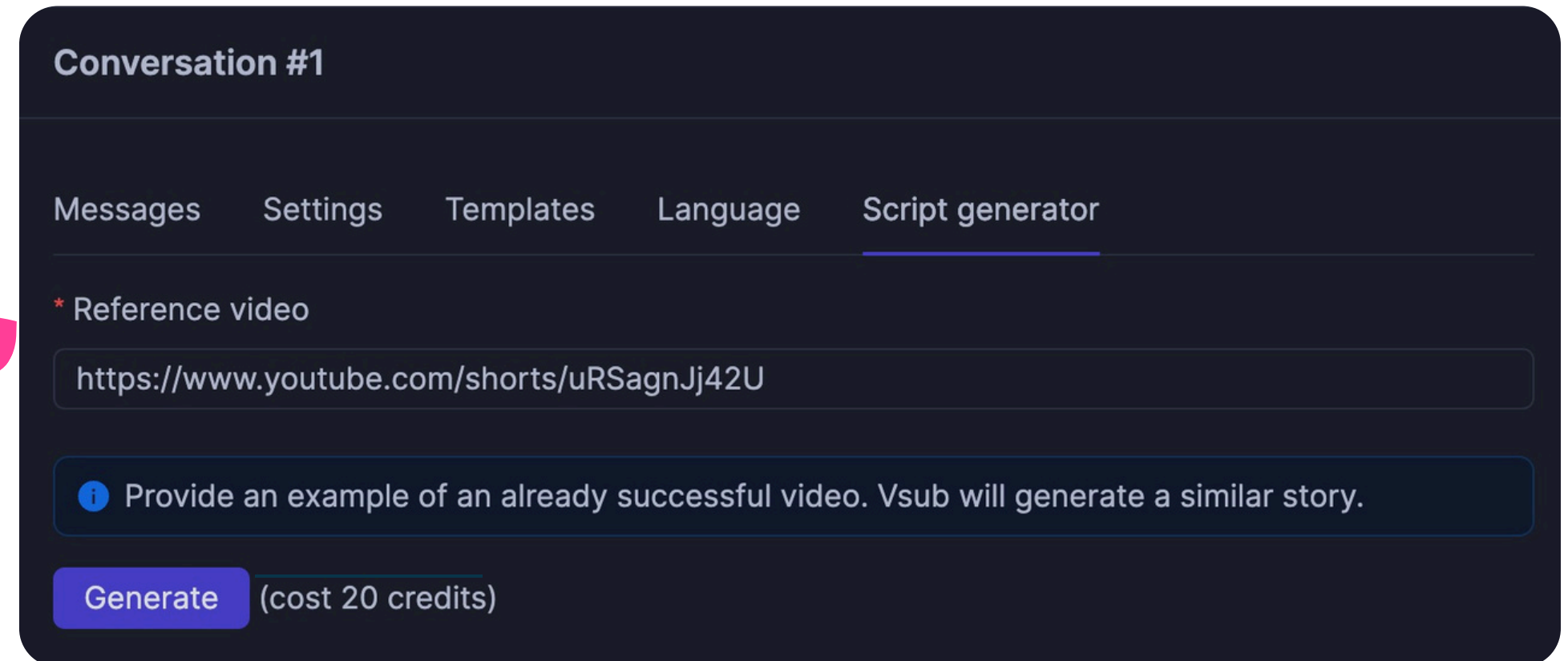

SCRIPT GENERATOR

Here you can paste a **sample viral video** from YT / TT, and vsub will automatically download and edit the script.

- If you like the script, simply click: **Use This Script**, and it will be automatically pasted for you
- If you want it to generate something else, click “generate,” but be careful, as **it costs 20 credits**

This is a **new option** and will be improved over time.

MESSAGES

We return to the first tab, which is Messages. This is where you **import or enter your messages** and modify it. If you import, remember to format the text like this:

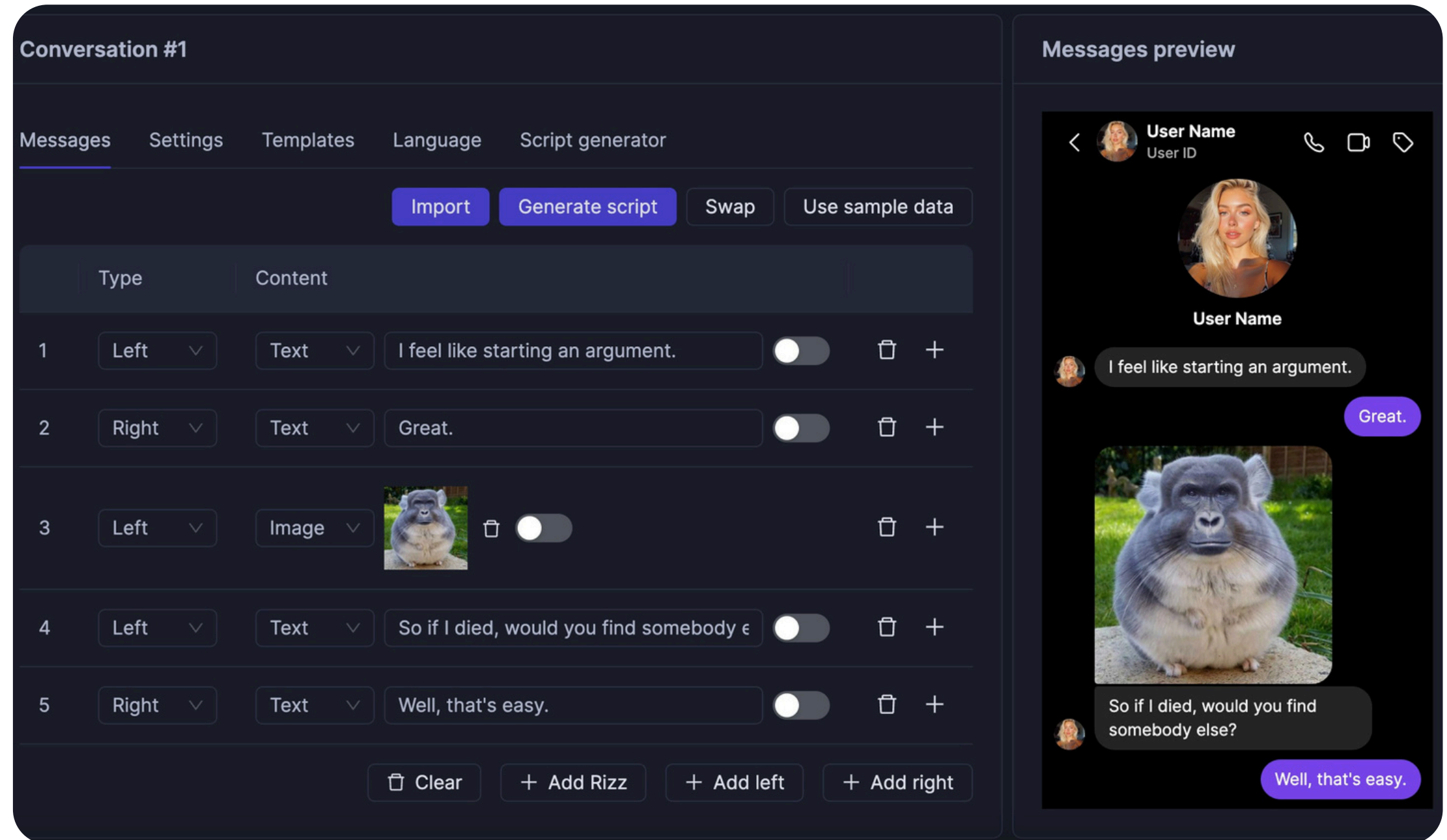
right;text;Dad! I want to marry 🥰

right;text;For what?

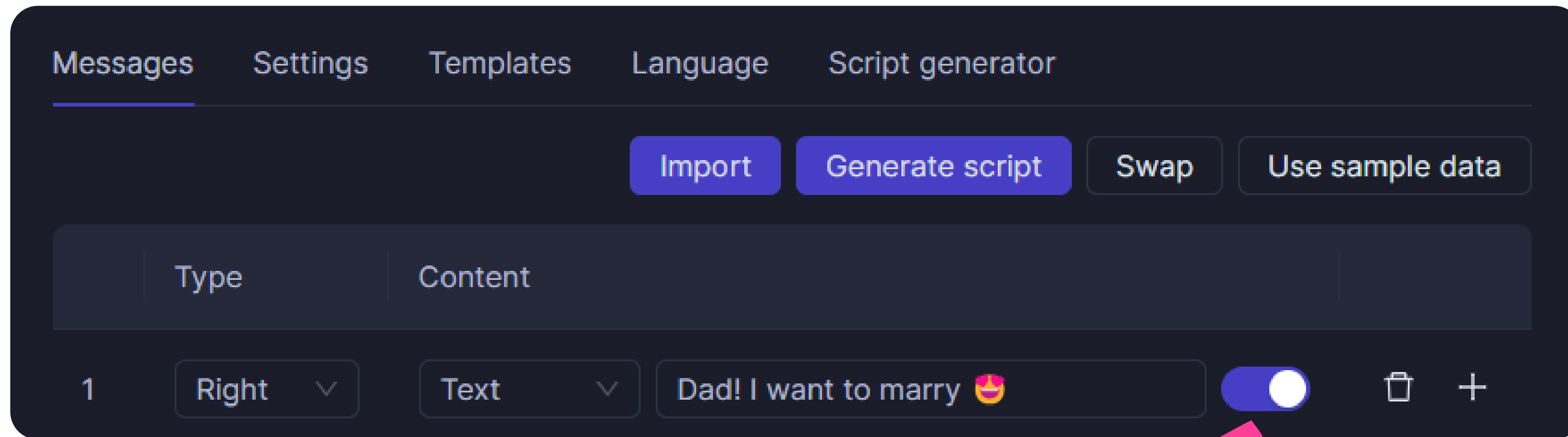

This slider is the “**EMPHASIZE**” option <- it actually changes your text to uppercase to create an Elevenlabs voice, which will be louder.

Type: choose on which side this particular message should be displayed (as the right or left participant in the conversation, more specifically as the sender or receiver)



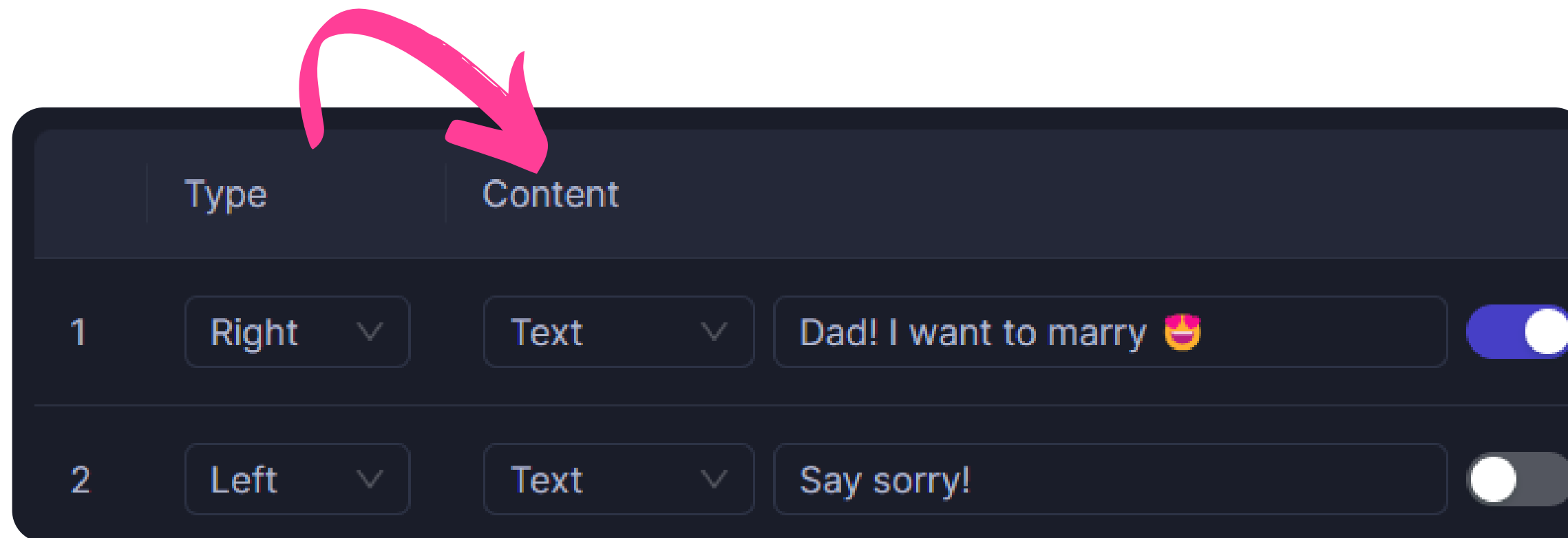

Content - here you choose the type of message:

- *text*
- *photo*
- *an ad for RizzApp** (you see it after creating the video)
- *an ad for PlugAI** (you see it after creating the video)

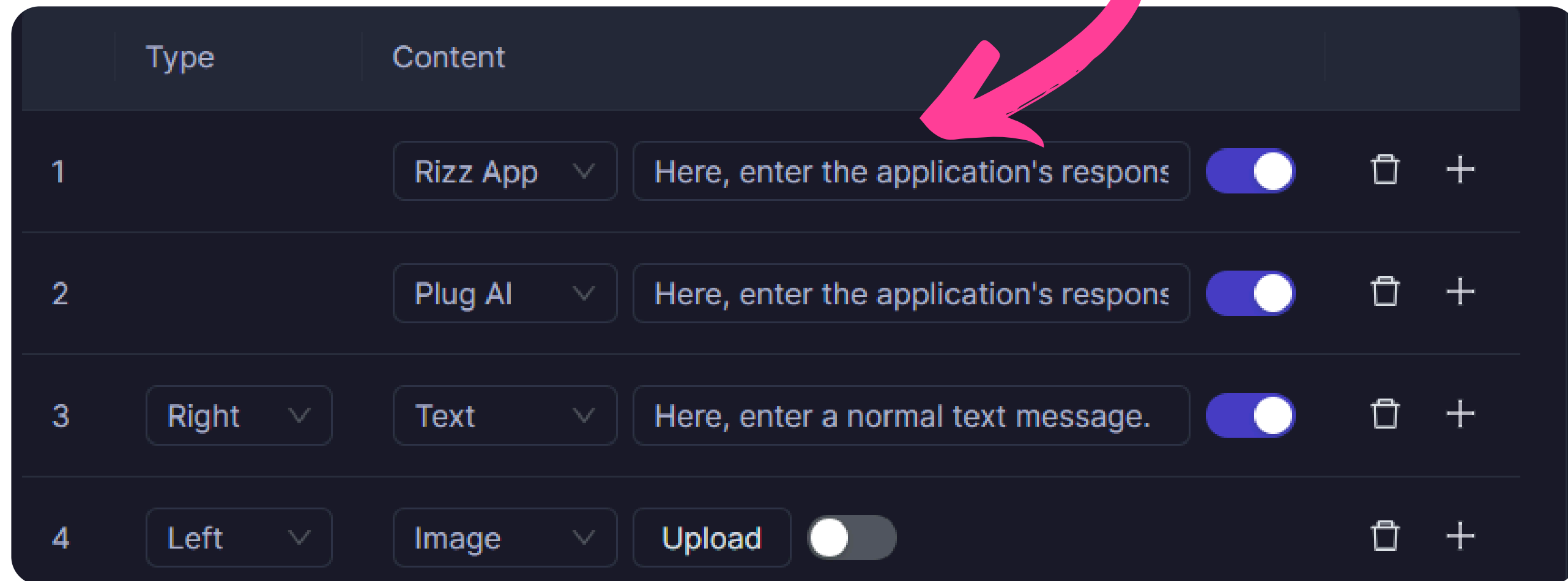

MESSAGES

In this section, you **enter messages** based on your selected "Content." If you are collaborating with RizzApp or PlugAI, this is the place to enter your rizz response from the app. A specific example is on the next page.

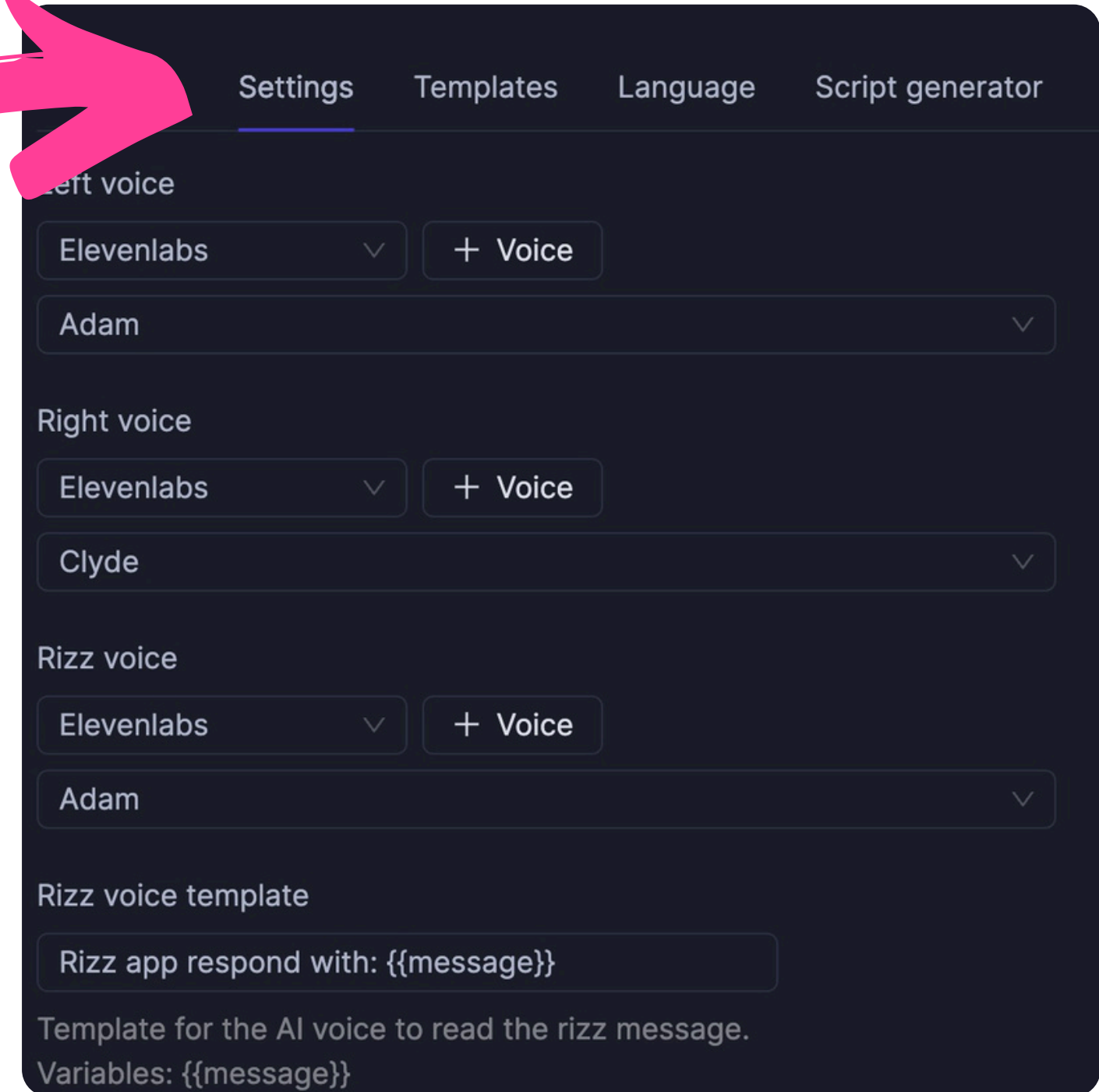
The first message is from the receiver (in this case, the girl being "rizzed"), then **a screen with the response** from PlugAI appears (that's why we have "Content" as PlugAI). **The third message** repeats the message from the PlugAI screen, but now as the sender (in this case, the guy). This is required by the apps so that the message appears both on the app screen and in the normal message screen. **The fourth message** is again from the receiver, reacting positively to our "rizz."

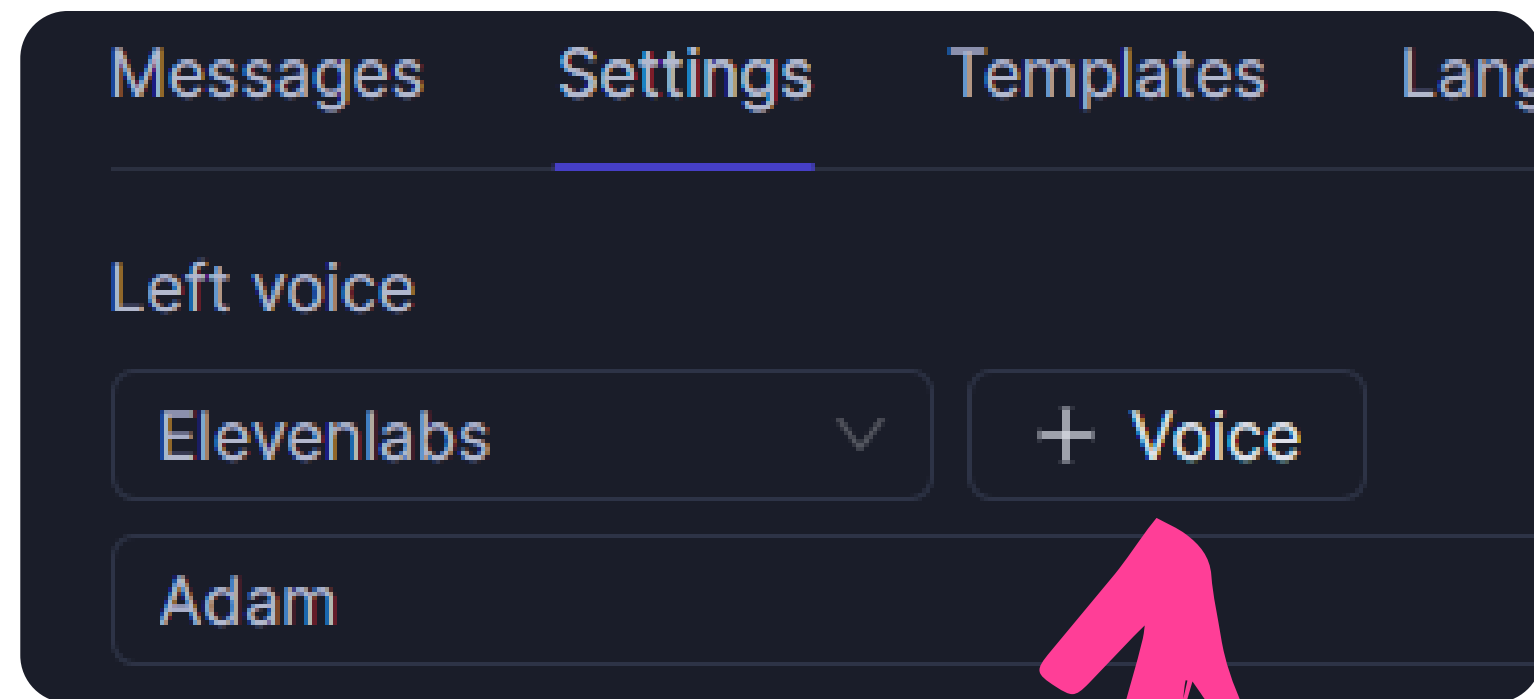
This section is very important: here you can **change the voices** of the participants



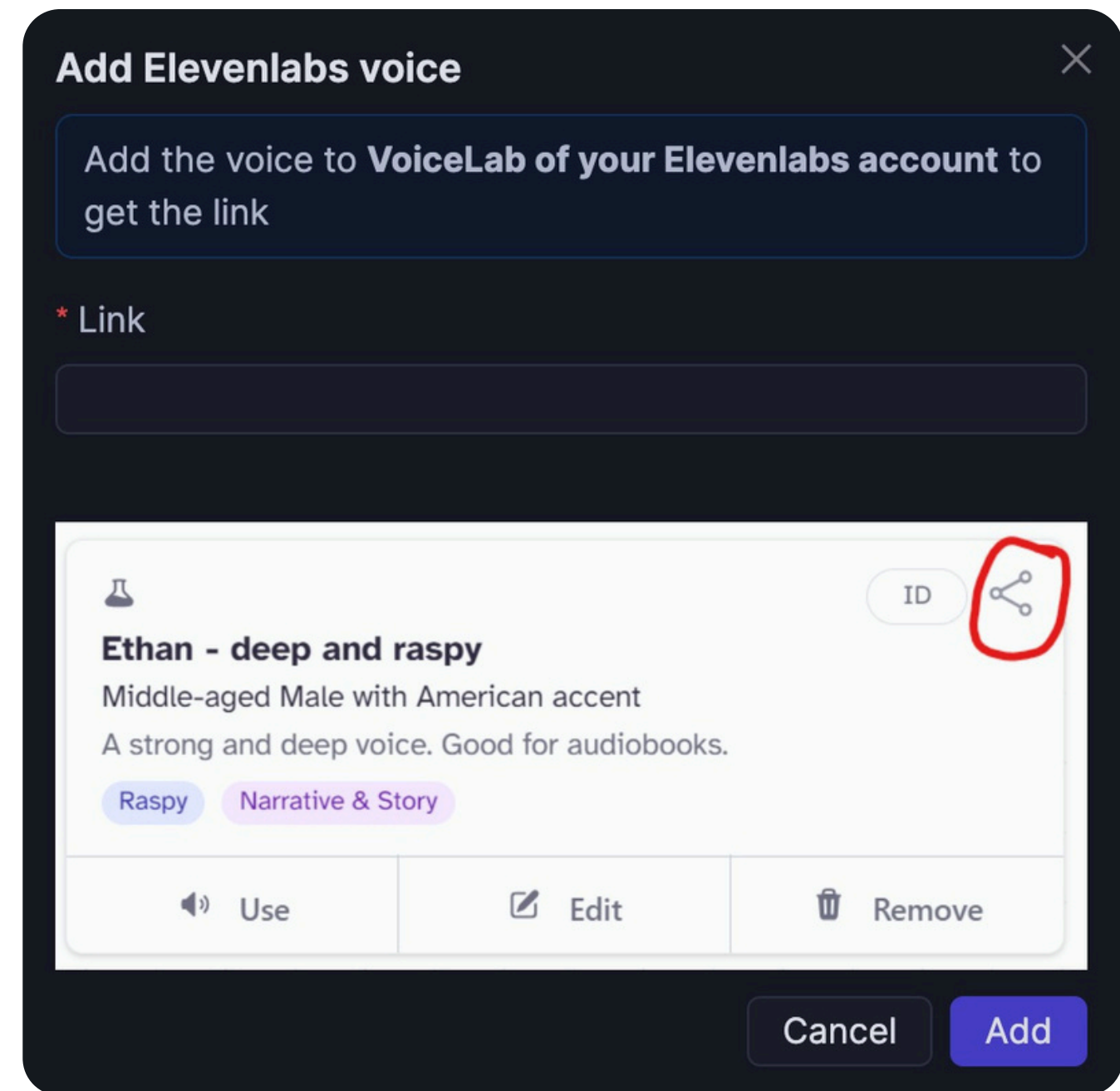

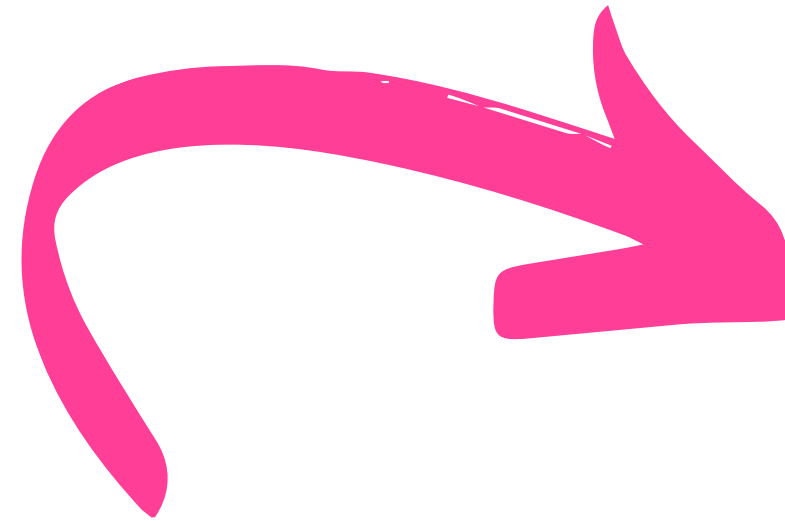
In the next section, which is **Templates**, you can **change the template** of your messages. The currently available templates are:

- **Instagram**

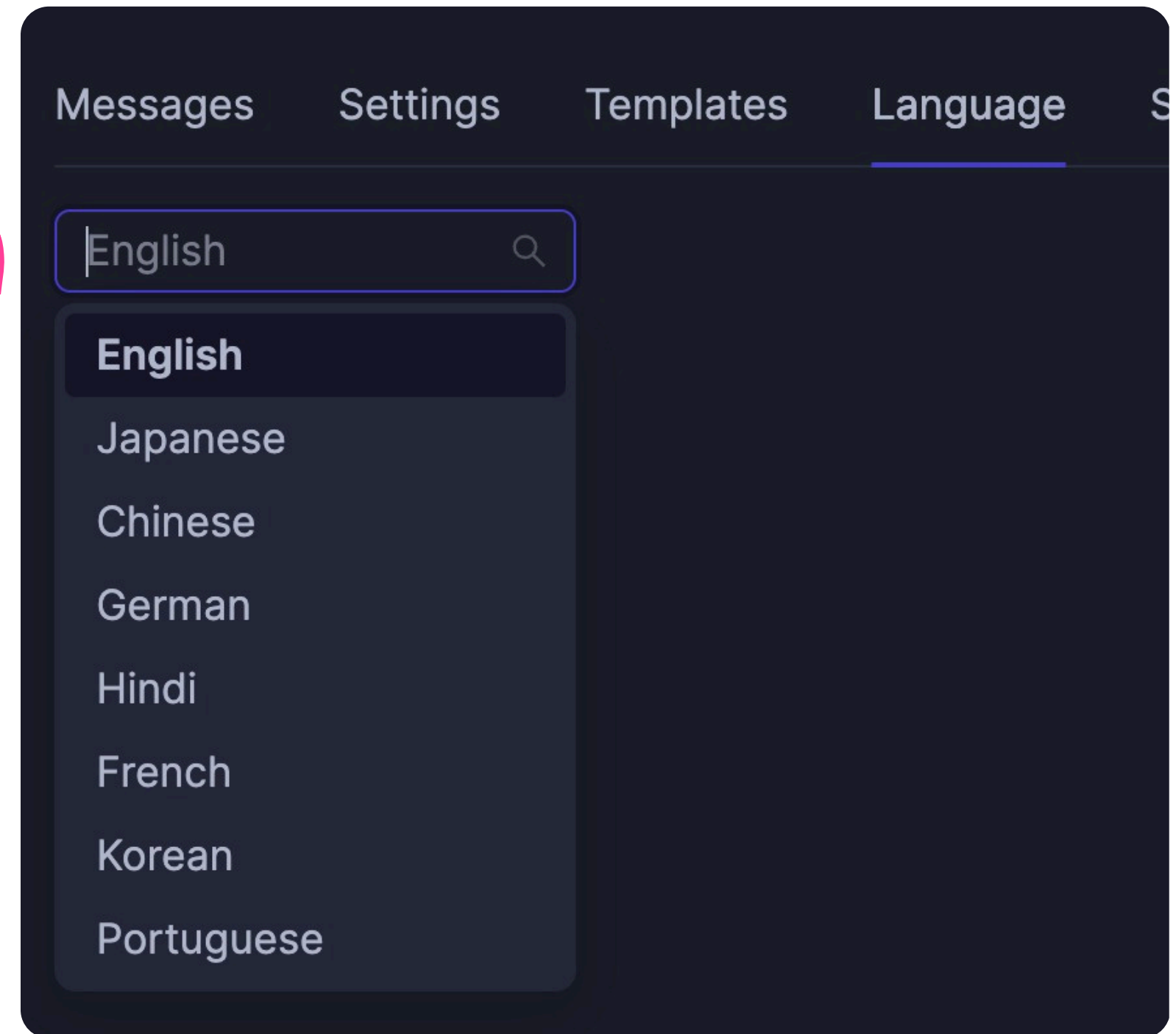
Here you can also choose between dark and white theme.

Here you can **change the language** in which the AI will perform the voiceover.

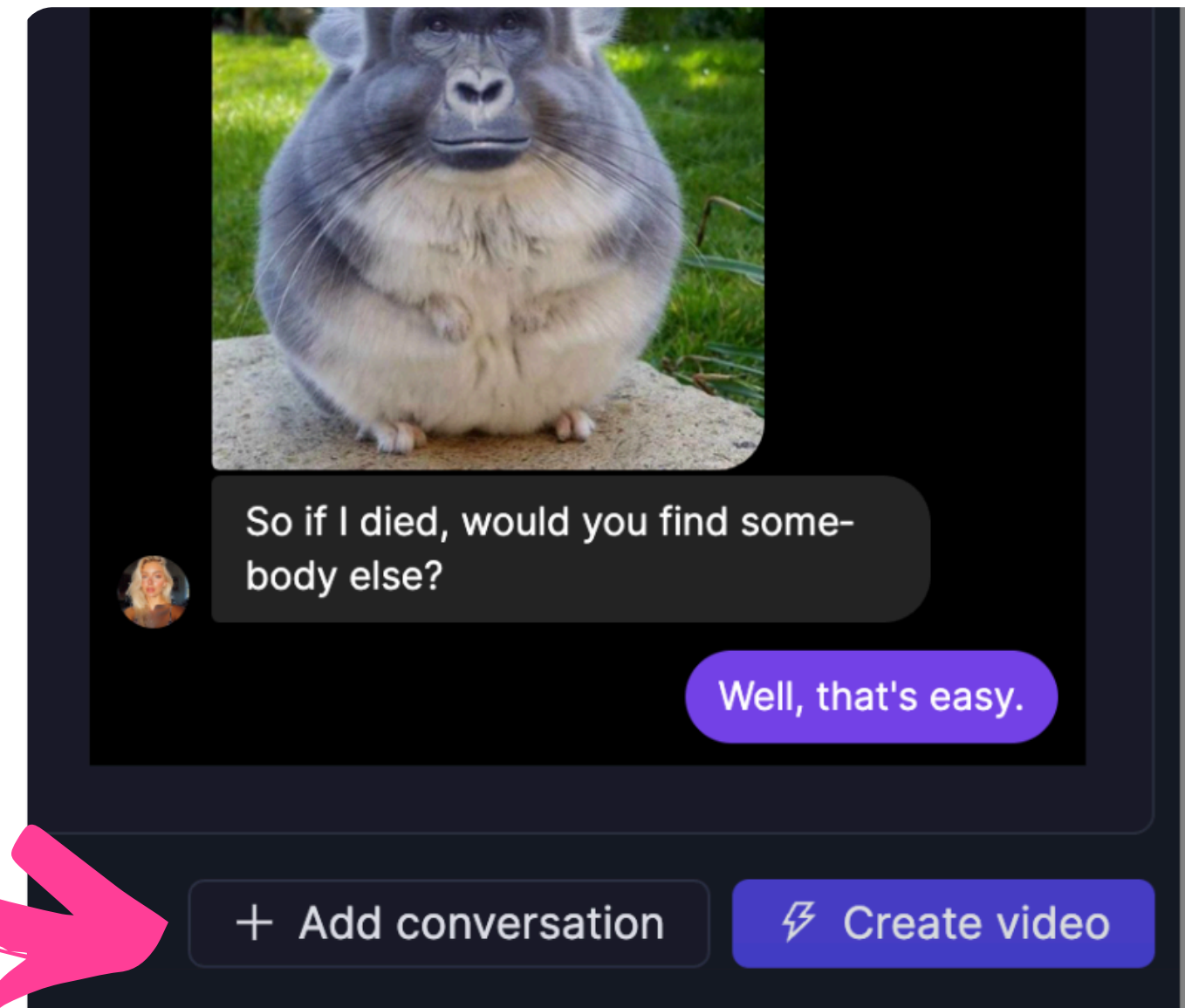

ADDING CONVERSATION

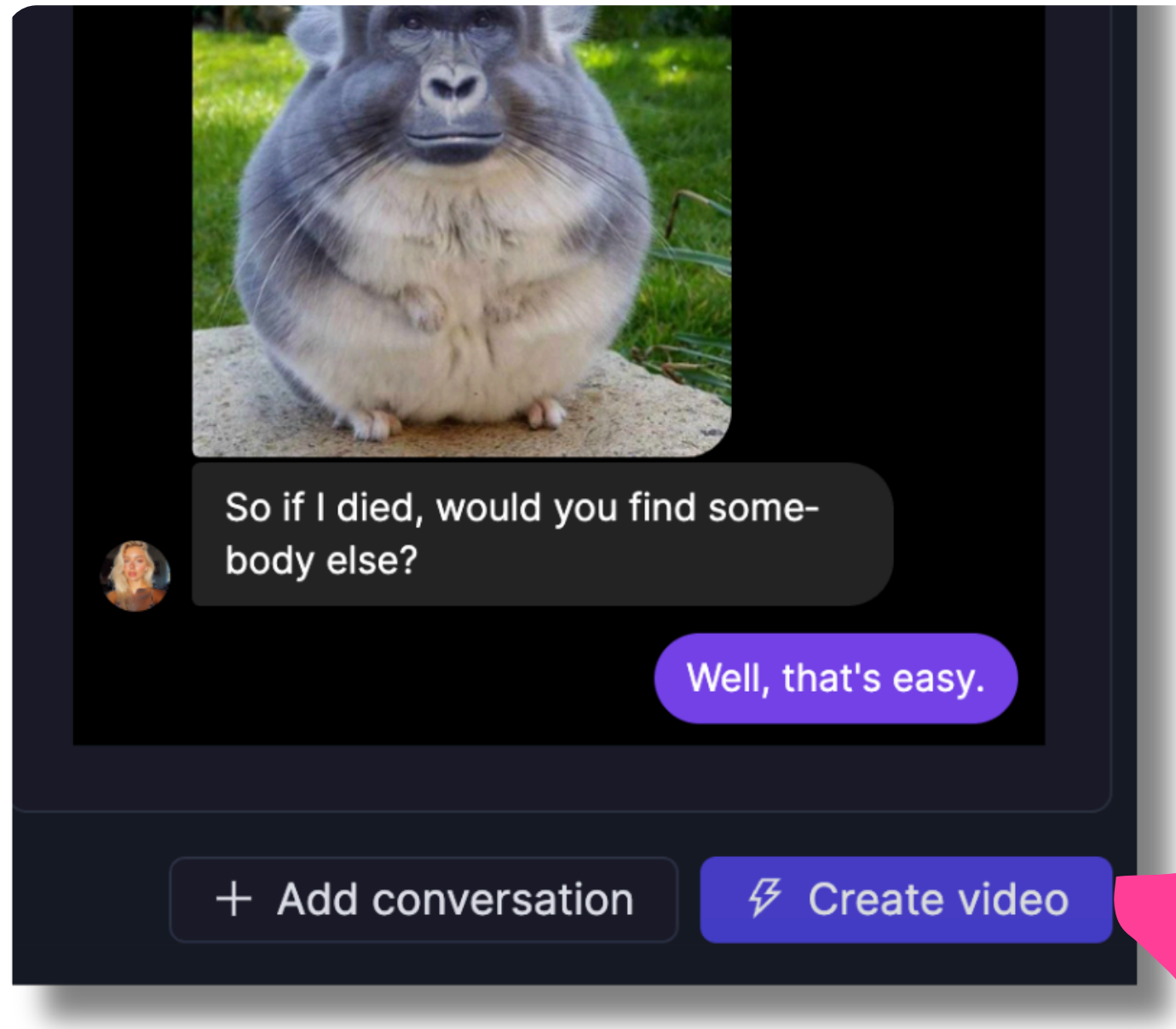
Additionally, if you want **more than one conversation** in the video (*for example, X first talks with his girlfriend, and then messages his friend*), click “add conversation” and set up the new conversation.

This option is at the very bottom under “Messages Preview.”

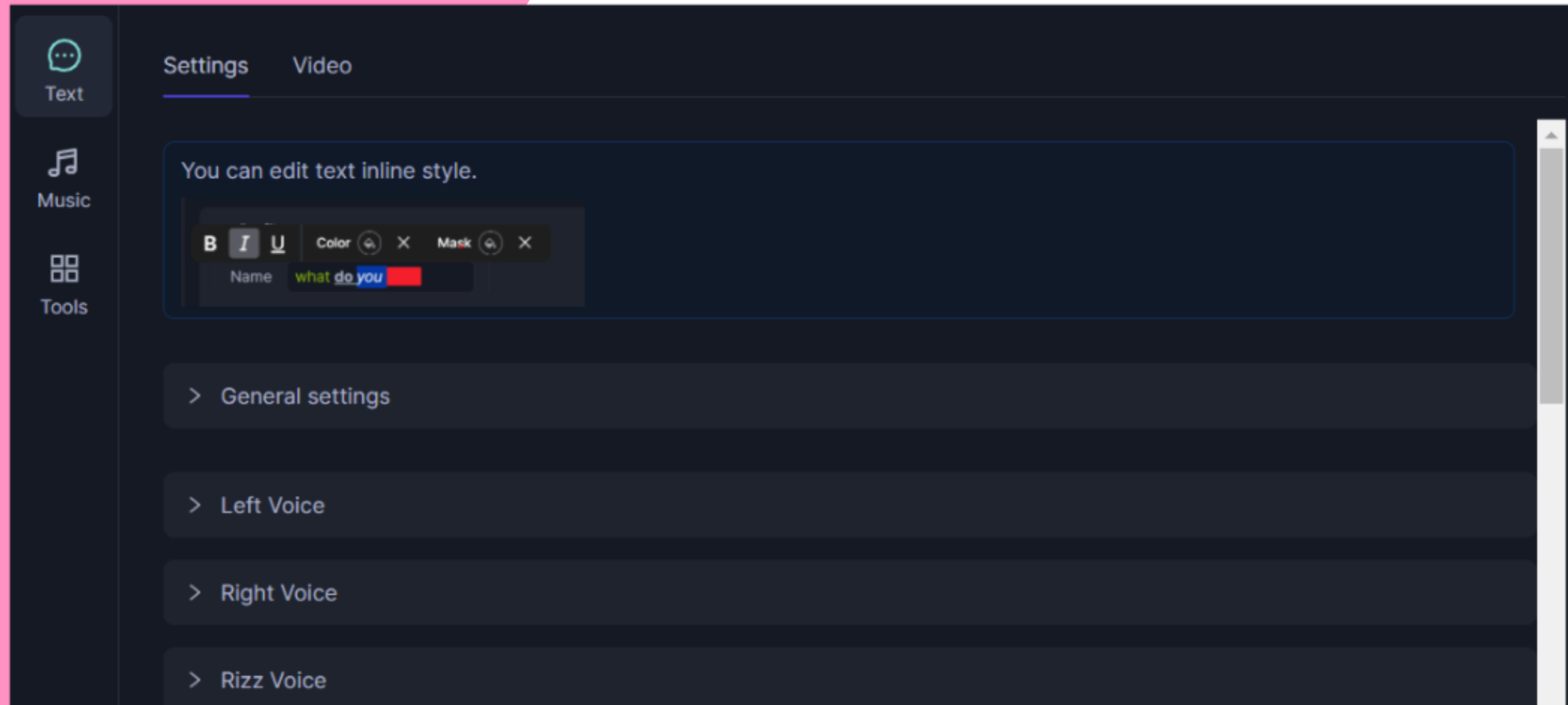
CREATE VIDEO



When you have set everything up in these five tabs, it's time to move on and click "**Create video**". After clicking, you will see a screen like this, and you need to wait a moment for the video to be generated:

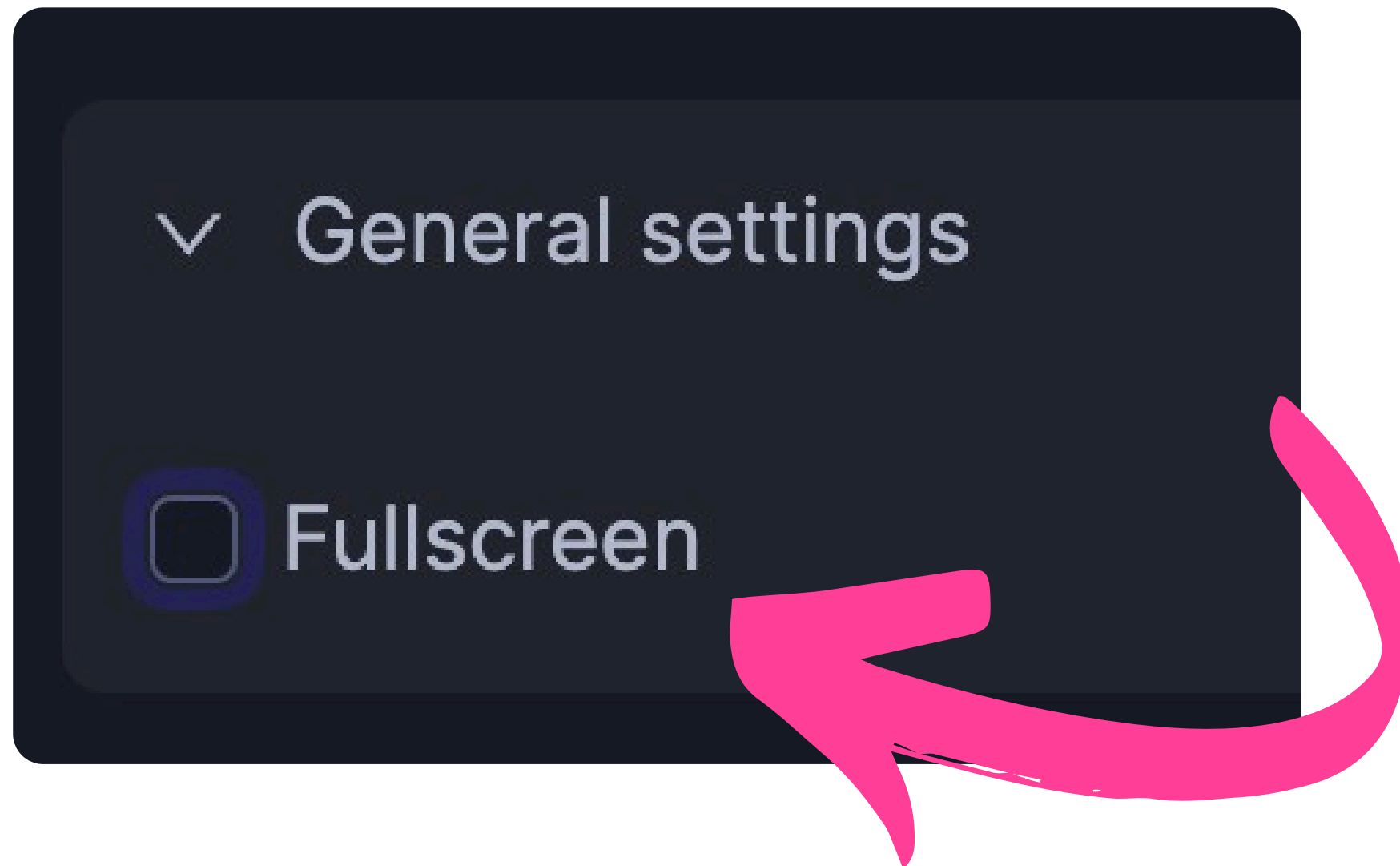

This section allows you to create a **full-screen video** (without a retention background).

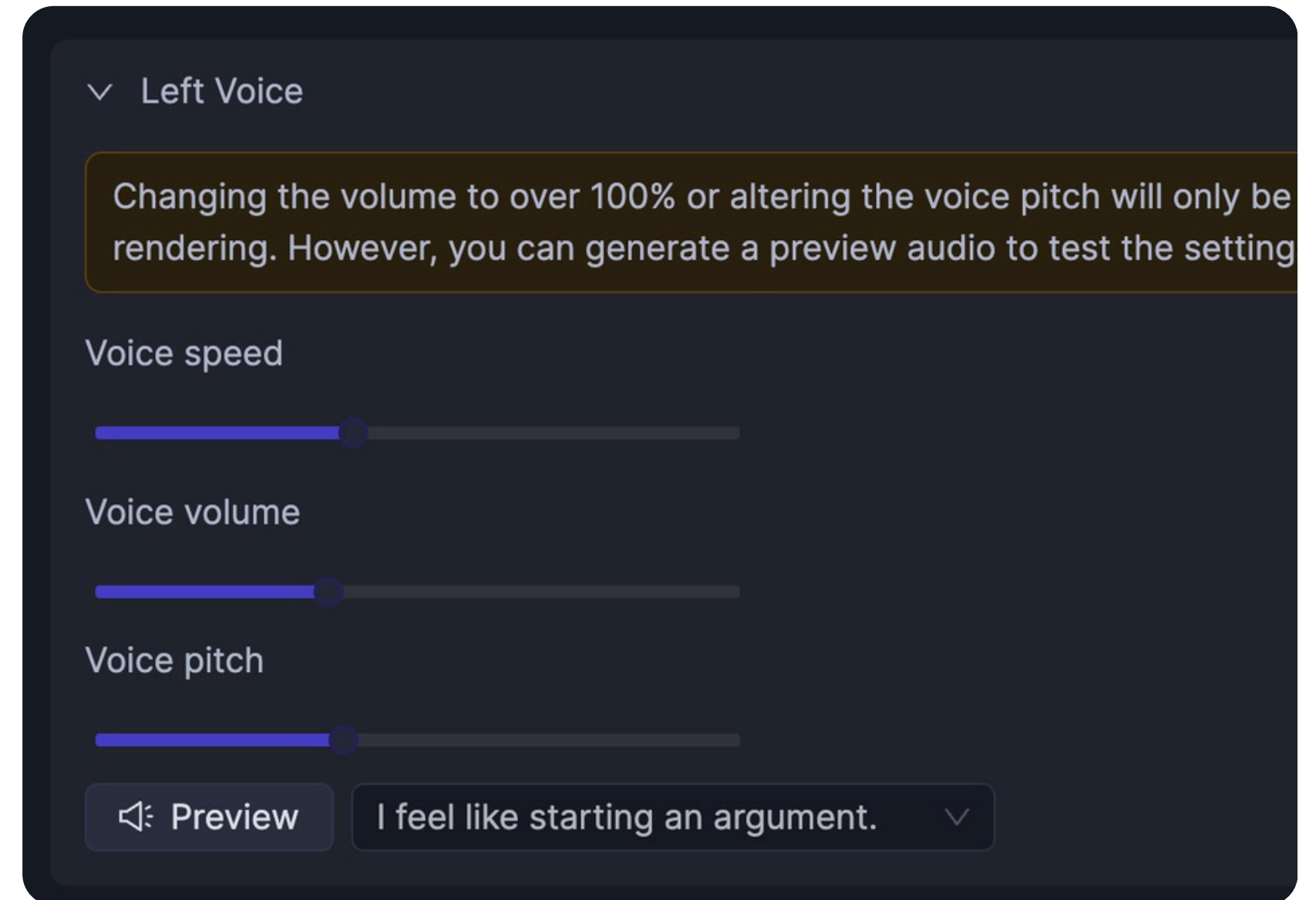

LEFT, RIGHT & RIZZ VOICE

In “**Left Voice**”, “**Right Voice**”, and “**Rizz Voice***” you can adjust your voiceover settings:

- **speed**
- **volume**
- **pitch**

The Preview option allows you to listen to it after making your changes.

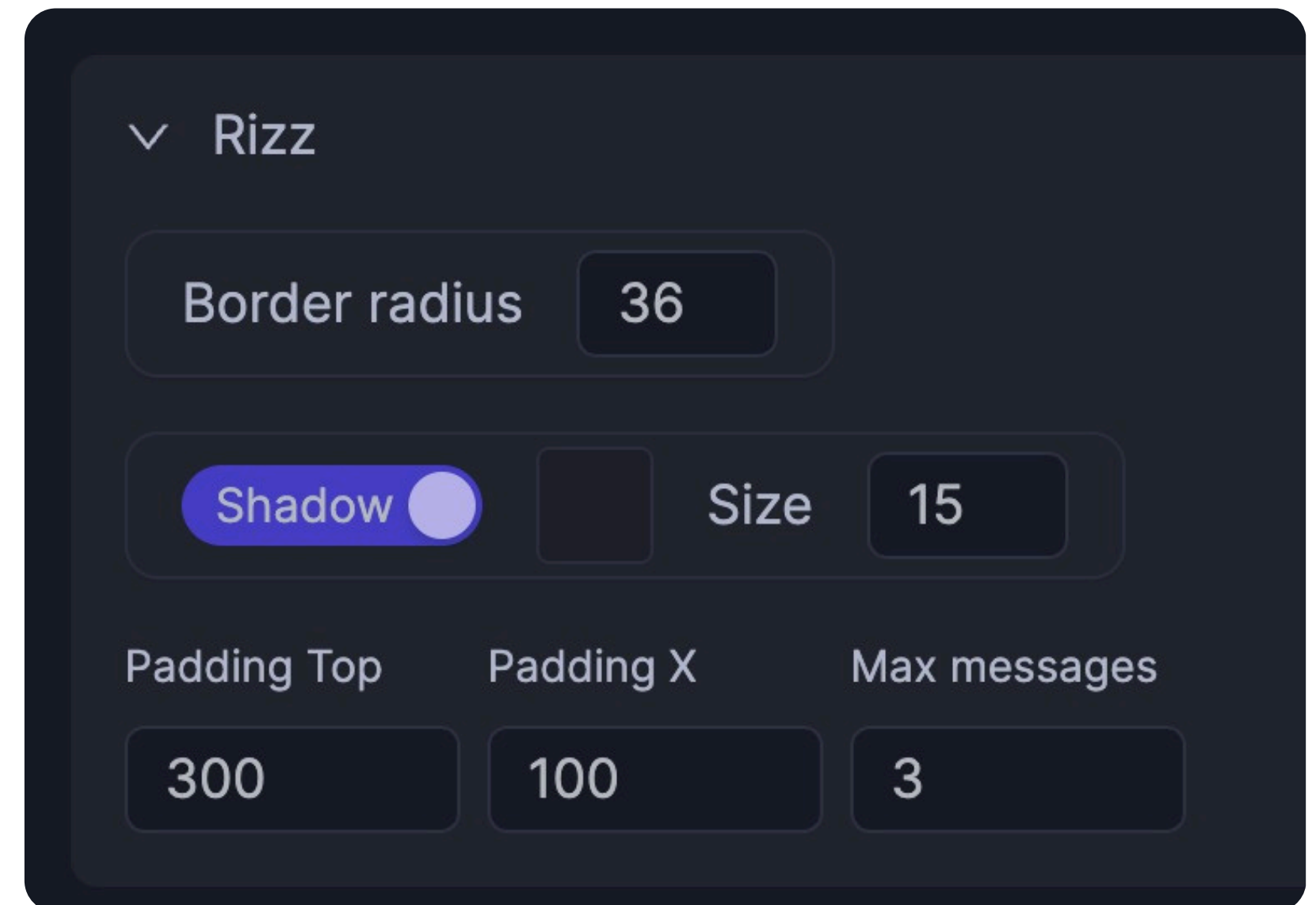


2. SETTINGS

*RIZZ

Here you set how the **"RizzApp/Plug AI ad"** should look, such as whether the frame should have shadows, the maximum number of messages on the screen, etc.

You will see your changes **immediately in the preview.**



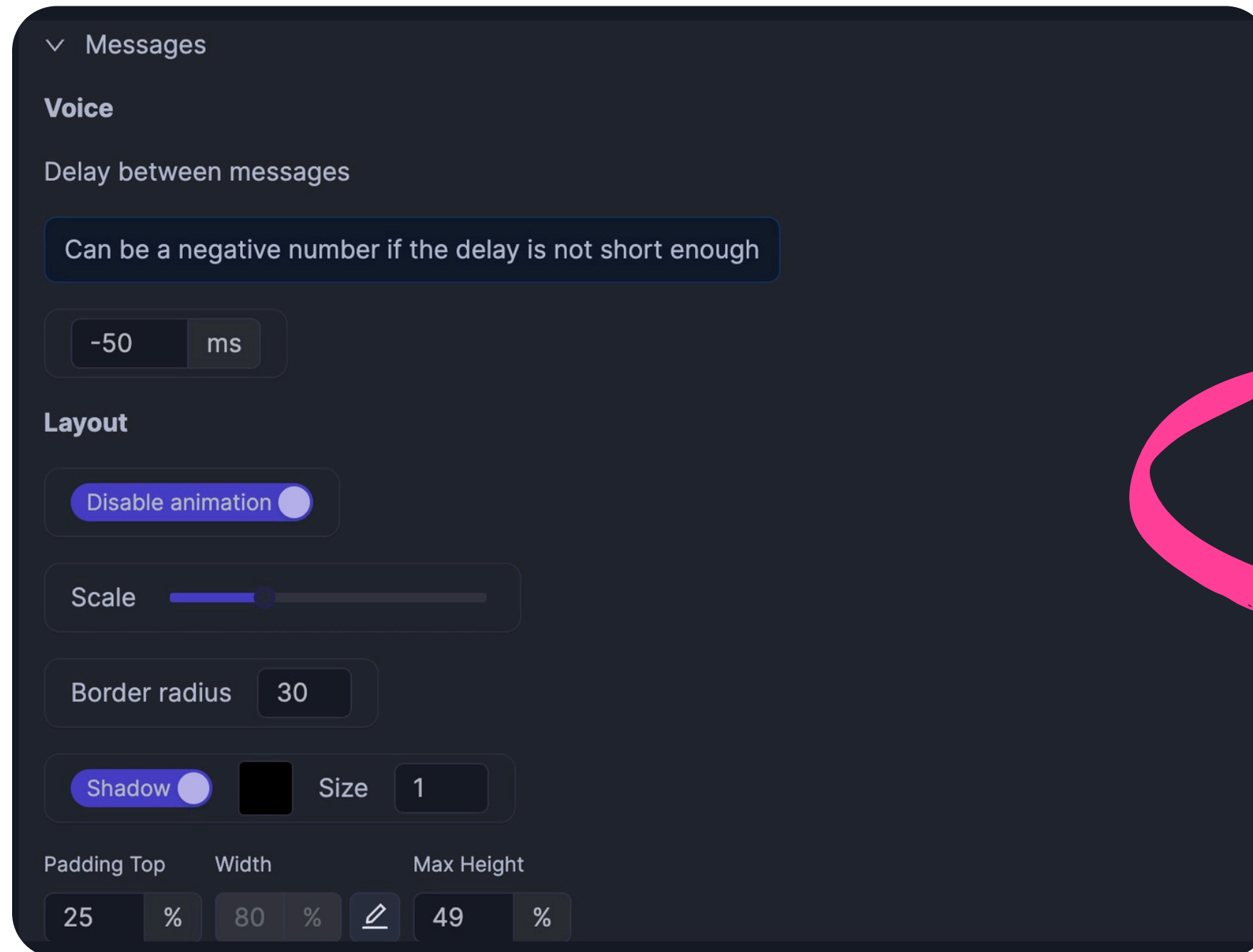

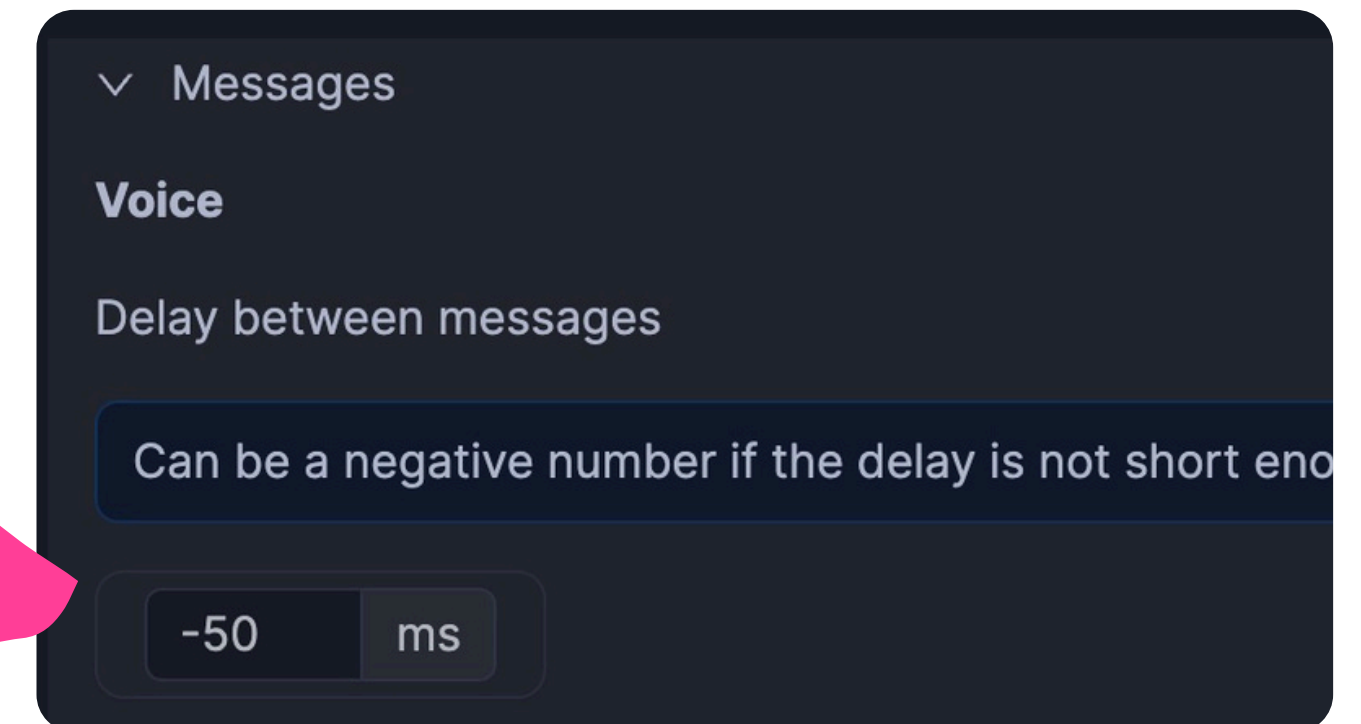

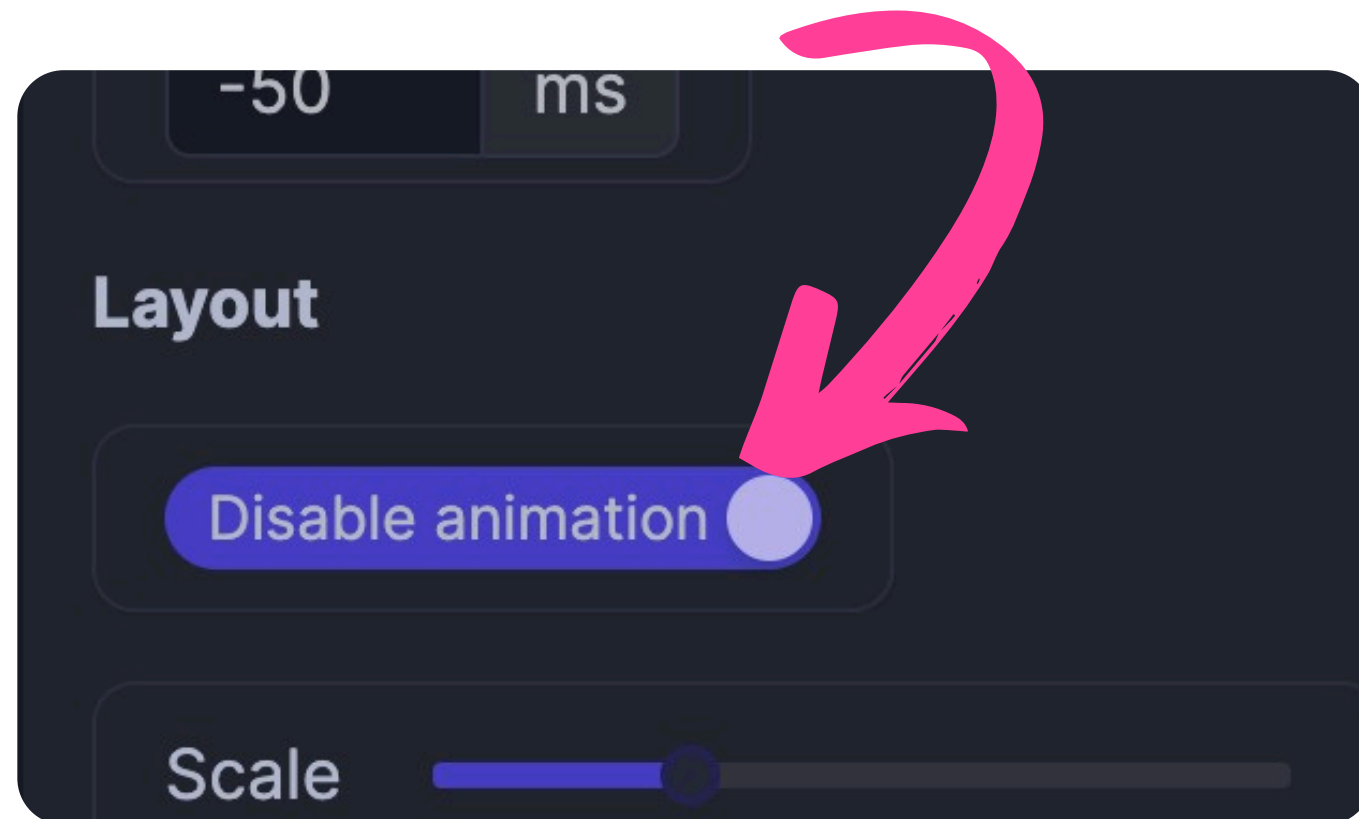

we suggest setting it to a **negative value**; this will make the conversation faster and more dynamic.

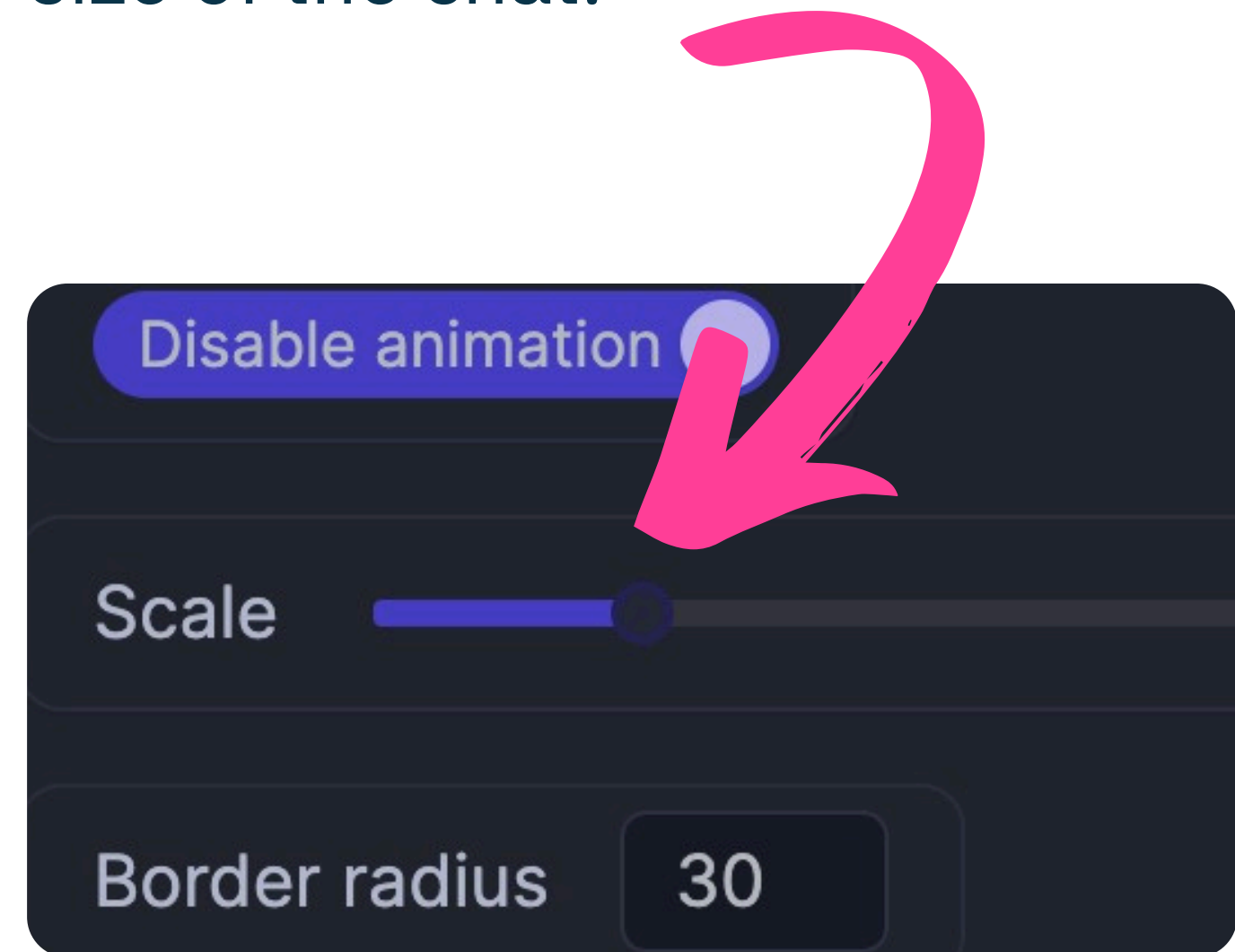

MESSAGES

Animation - This simply defines how the messages will appear, whether they should slide in smoothly like in Premiere Pro or pop up suddenly.



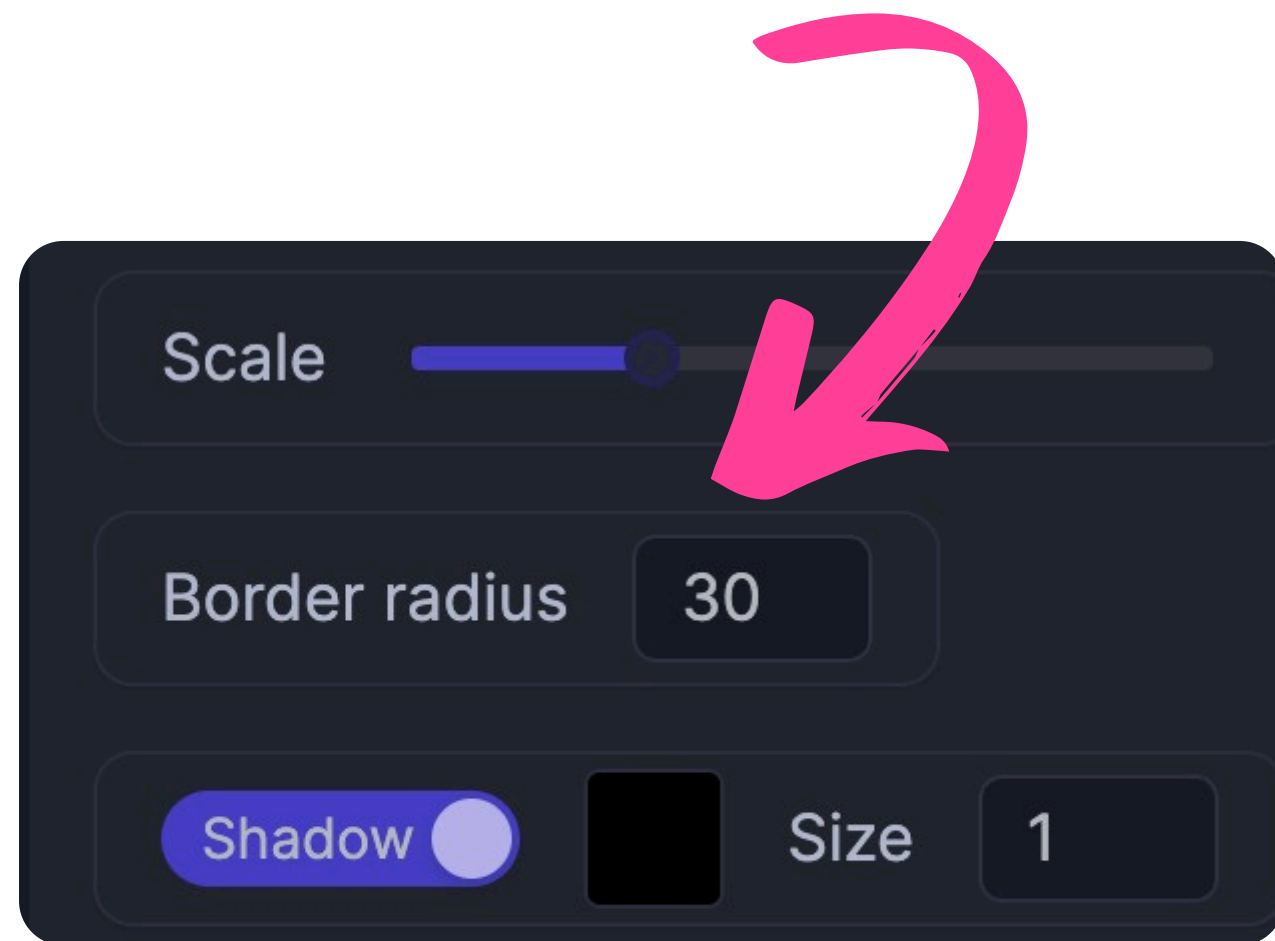
Scale allows you to adjust the size of the chat.



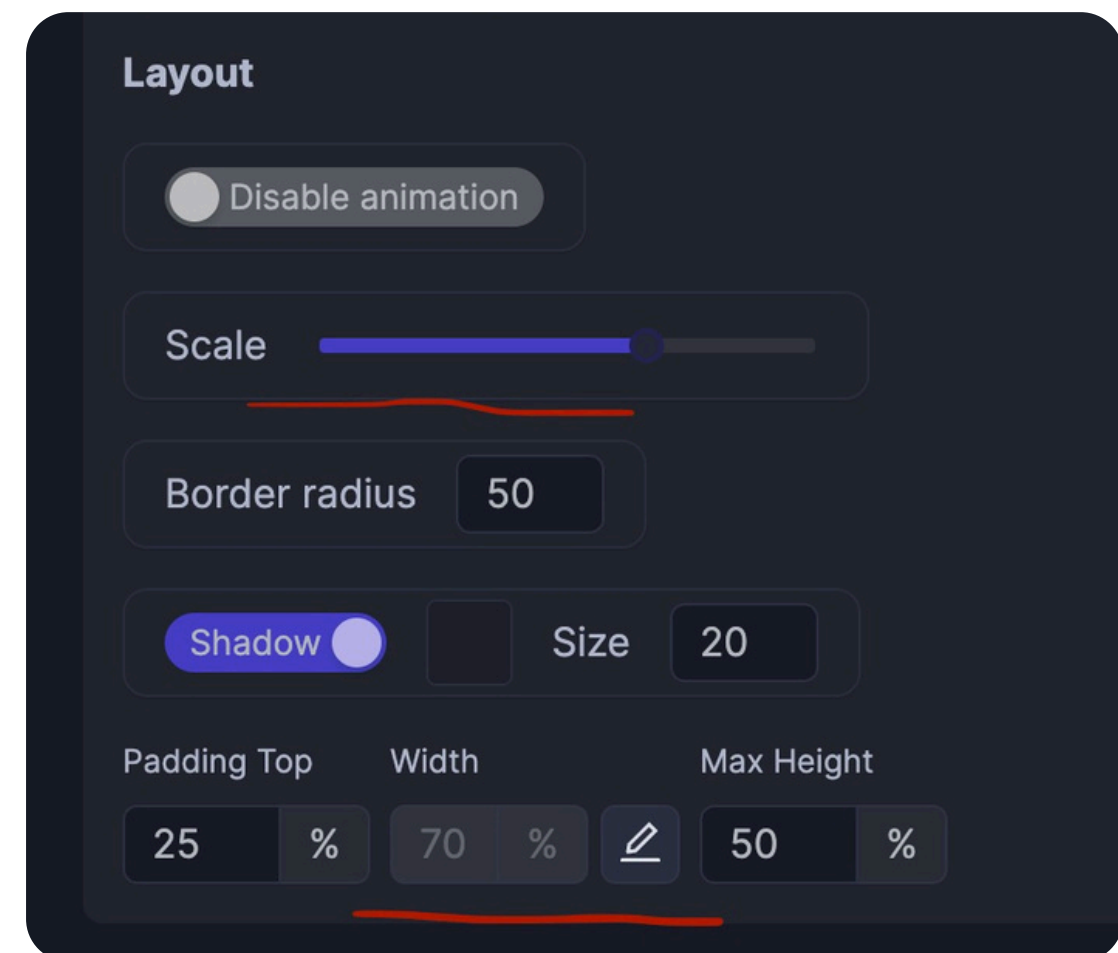

MESSAGES

Border radius set to 0 means rectangular frames; the higher the value, the more rounded the corners.



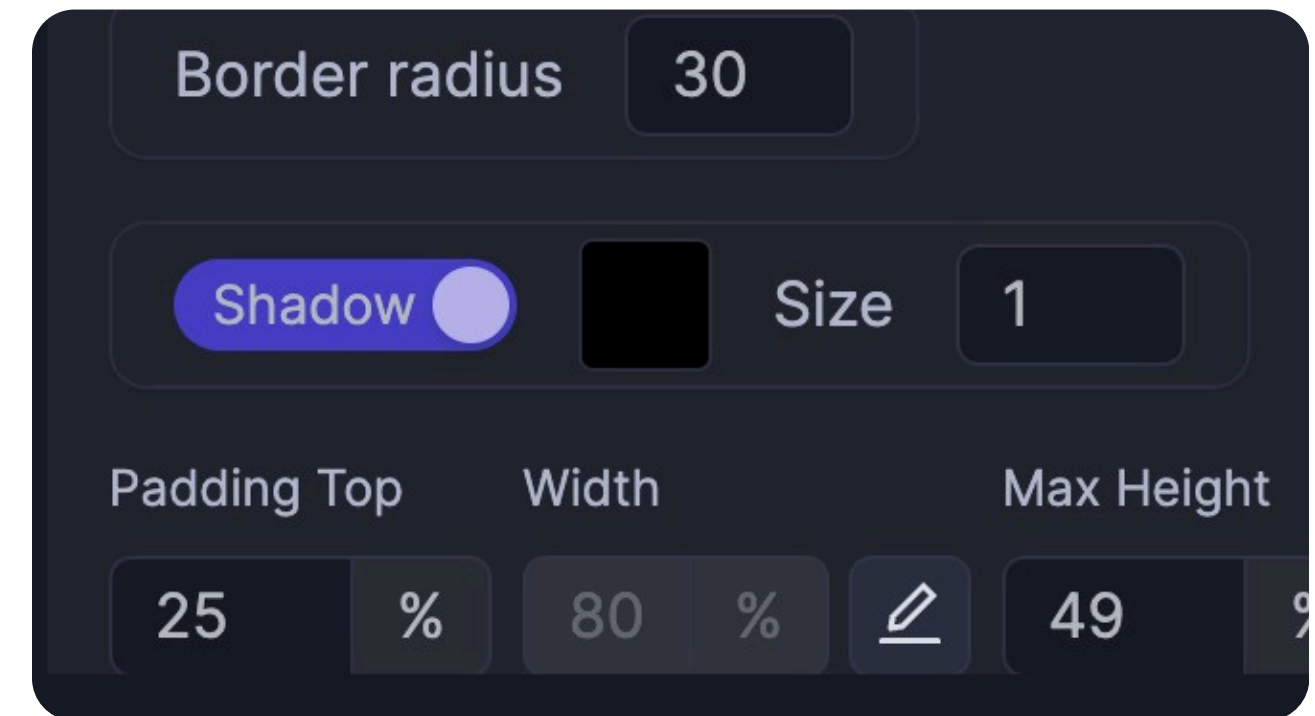
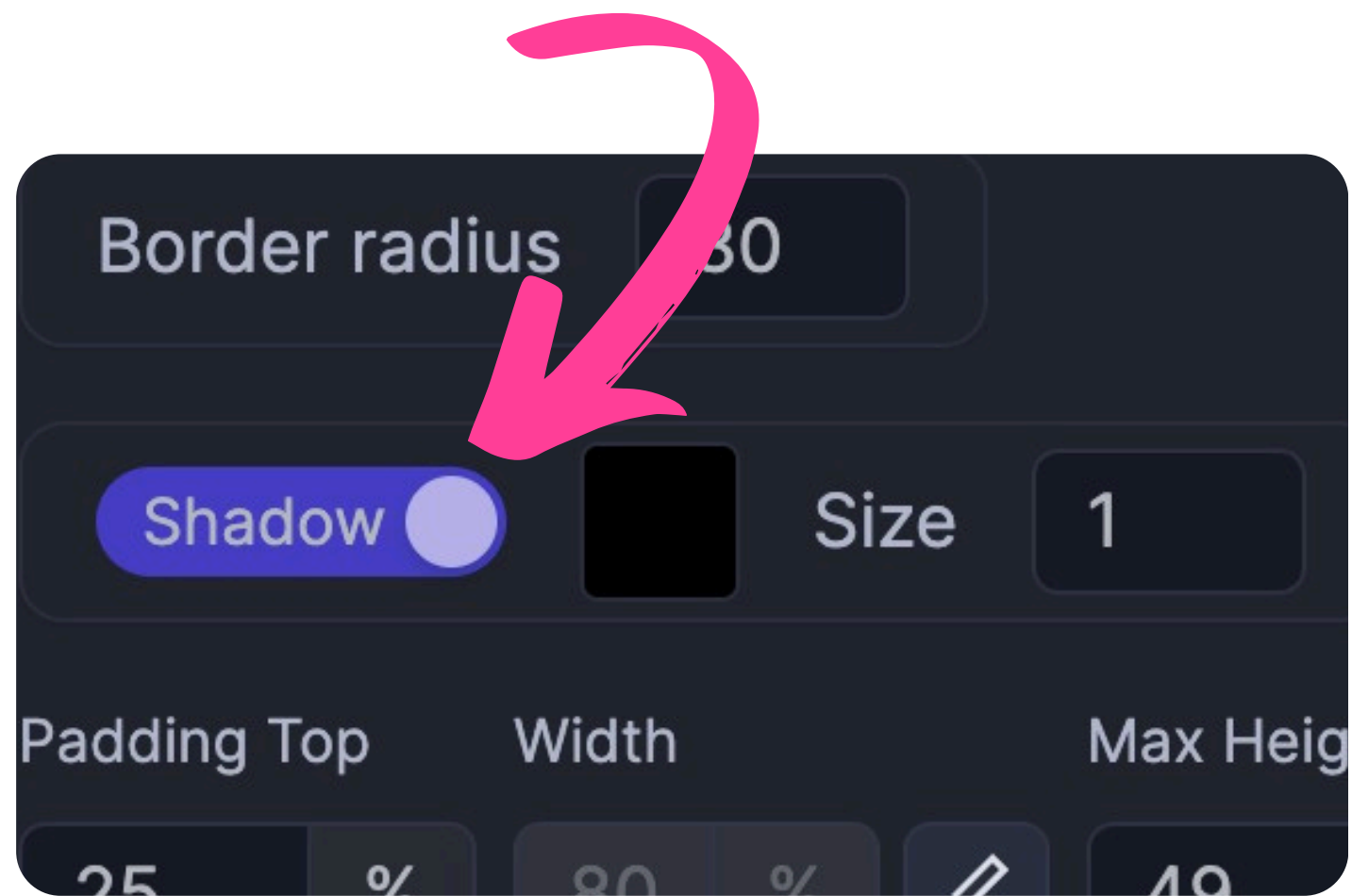
It's not possible to change font size but there is a trick, you can **scale it and reduce width at the same time** to have the expected font size

Shadow refers to the shadow effect. We suggest setting it to 1 for a subtle look.



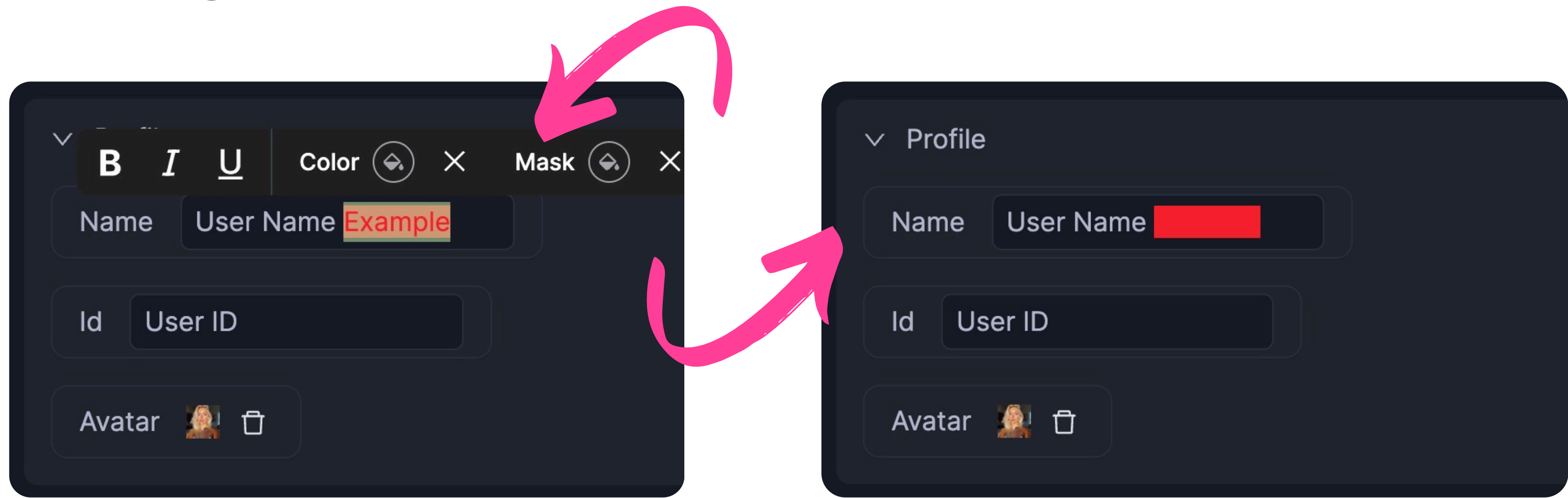
These options at the bottom are simply for positioning the entire chat with messages.

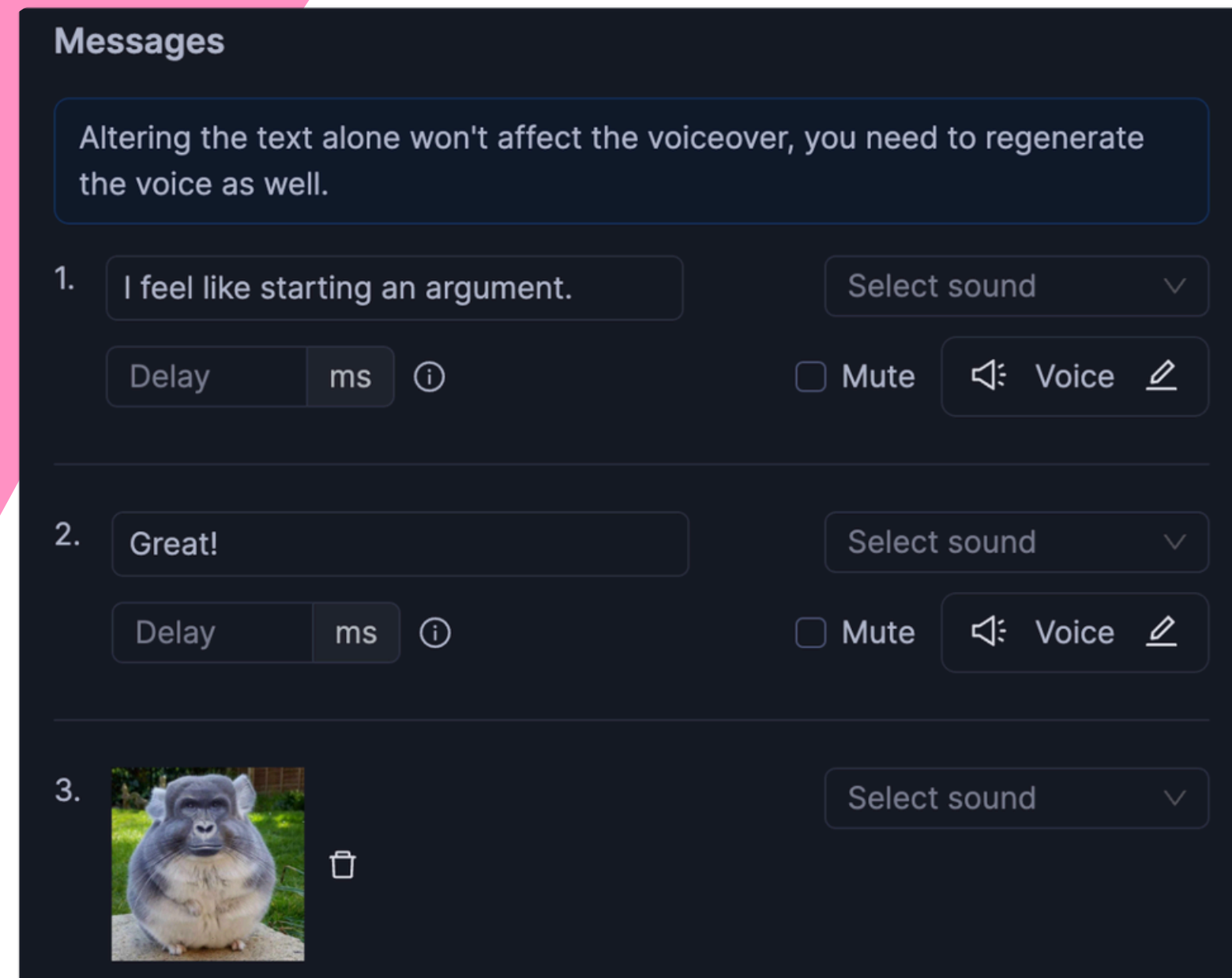

PROFILE

In **Profile**, you can also edit the name and user ID (Instagram).

By selecting "**Mask**" you can censor the name (this is a common practice with the Instagram template).



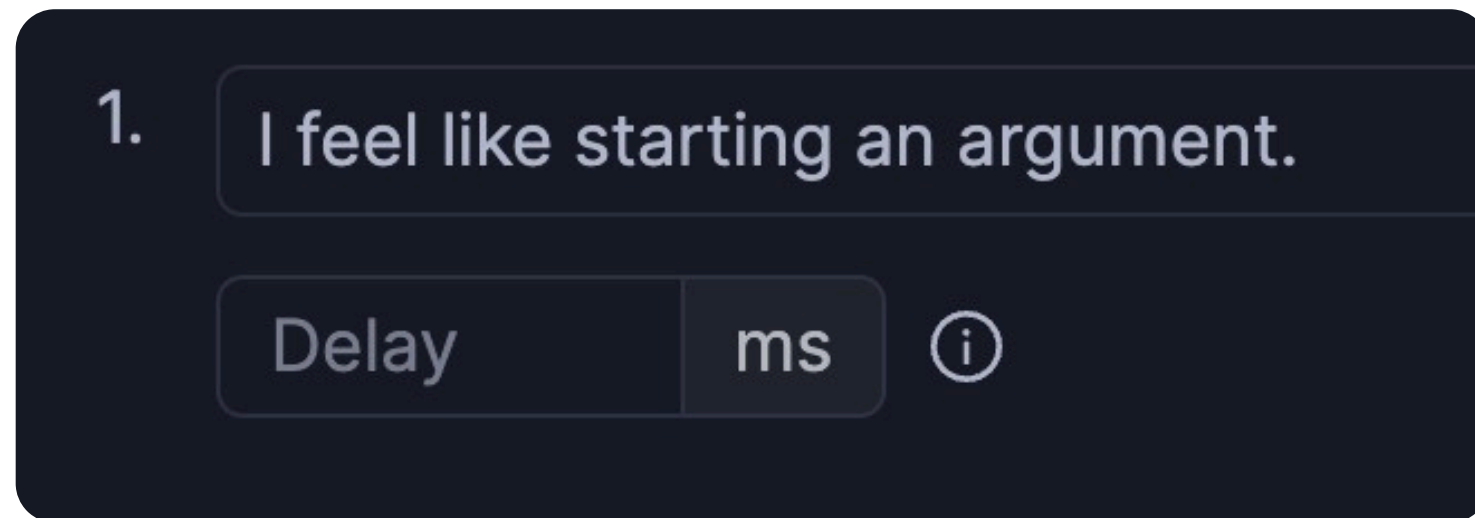


3. CUSTOMIZE

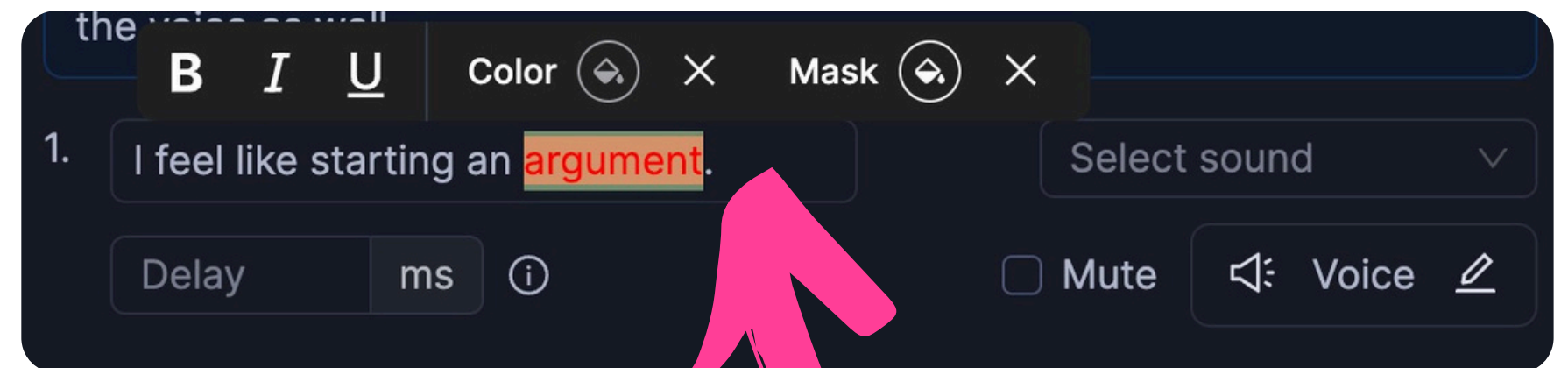
The customization section is still located in the "Settings" tab, just below "Profile."
Let's start with the section called "Messages."

MESSAGES



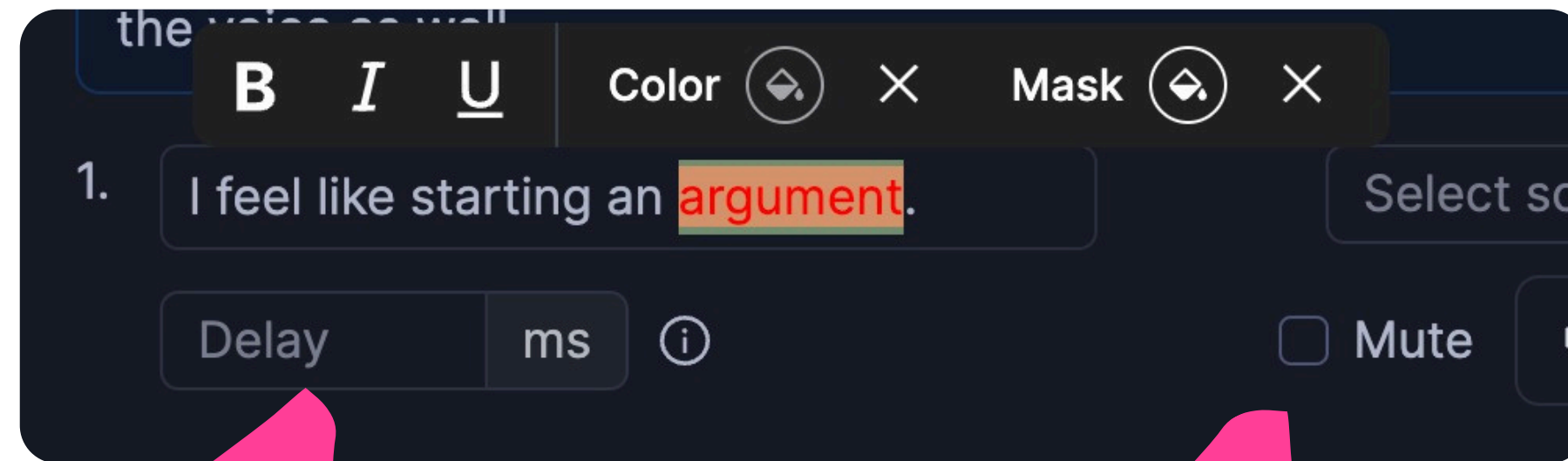
Just like with the profile, after selecting a message, you'll see the option to customize the text. You can **"censor"** selected words using **"mask"**



Remember, the voiceover will still **read the hidden word.**

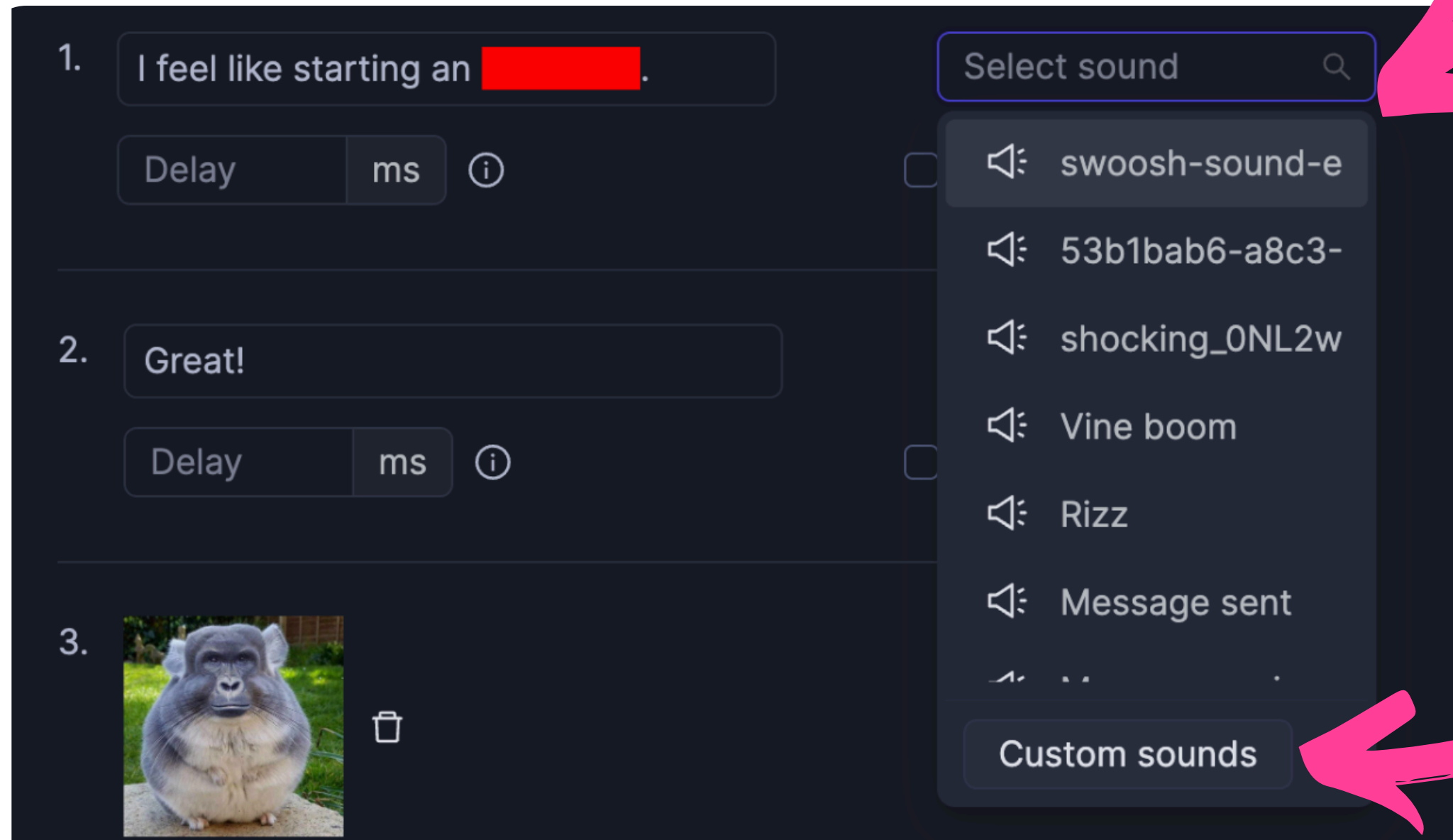


Here you can **delay** this **specific message** along with its **voiceover**.

And here you can **mute the message** (the message will appear on the screen, but there will be no voiceover).

SOUND EFFECTS



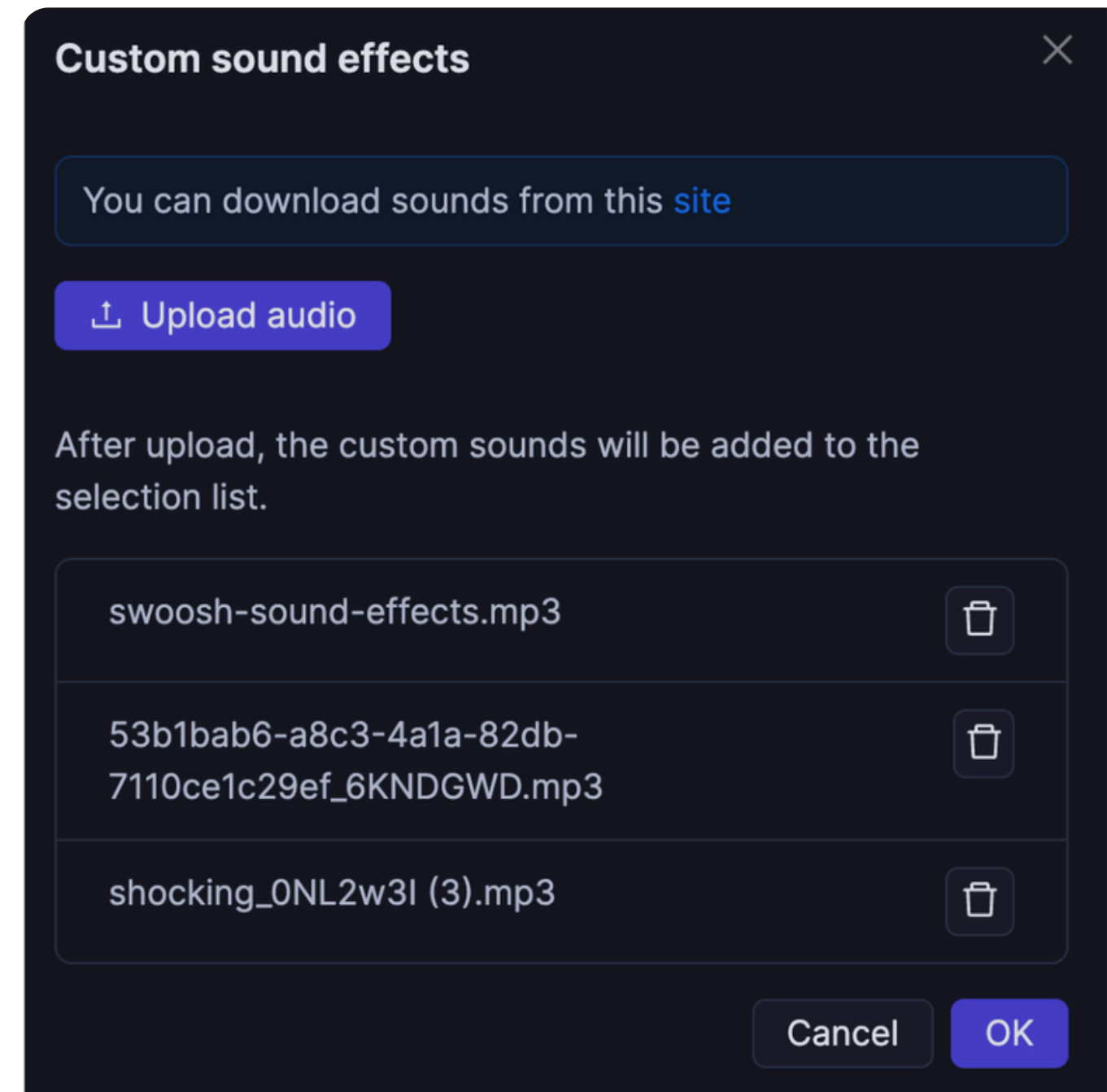
Here you can add **sound effects** to each message, which improve video retention.

And by clicking "**custom sounds**" you can upload your own SFX.

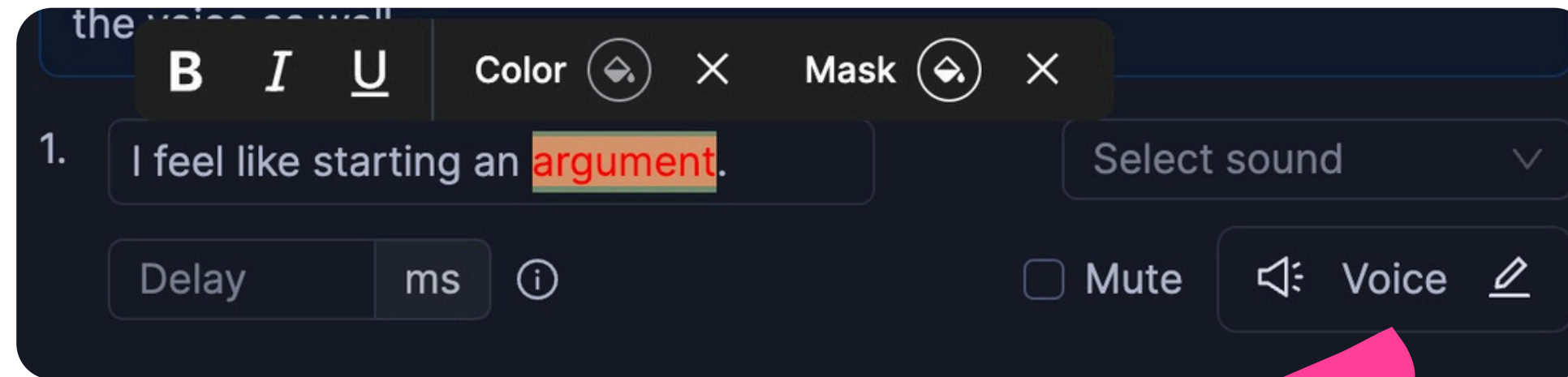

For downloading sound effects, the recommended site is **myinstants.com**.

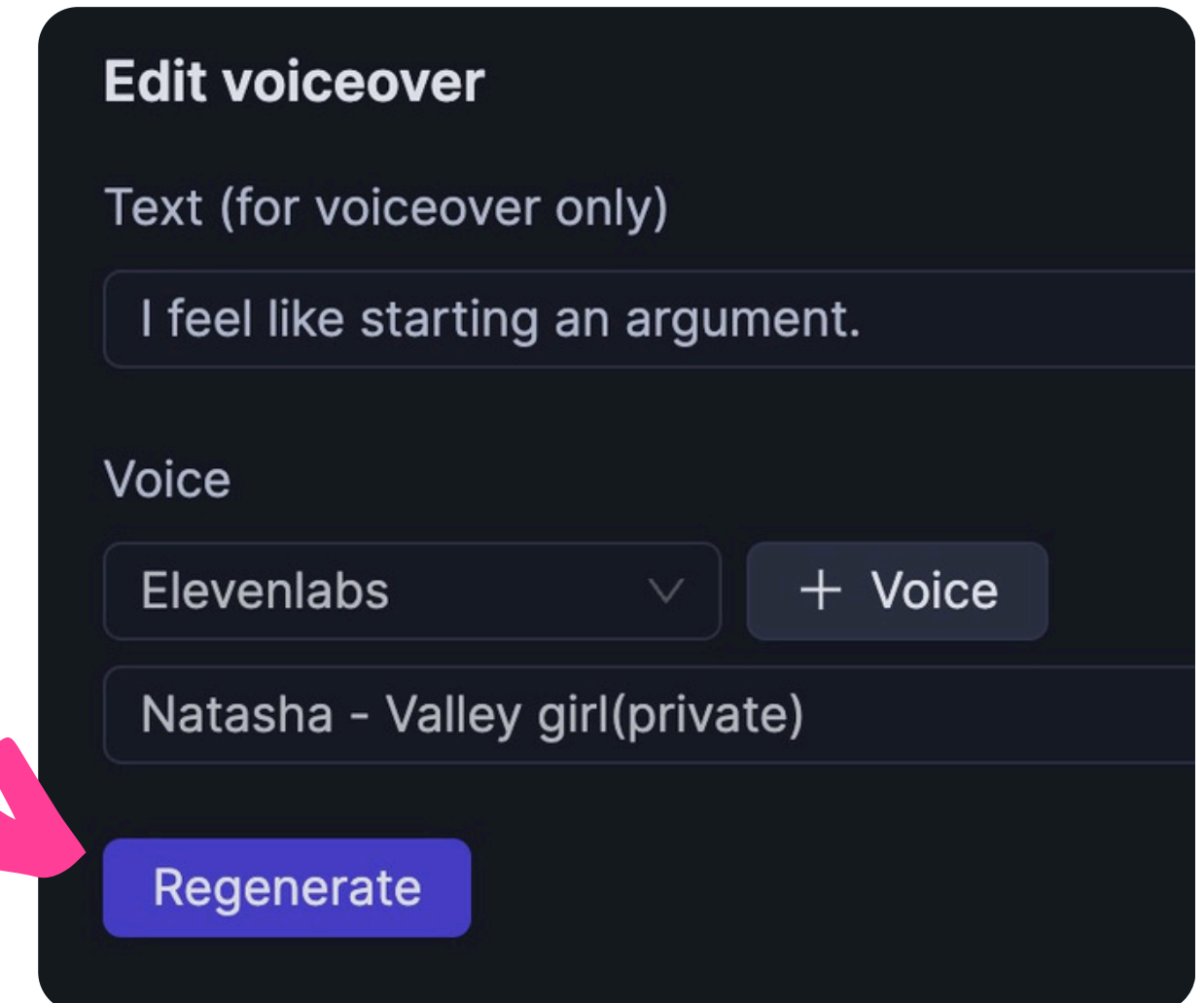


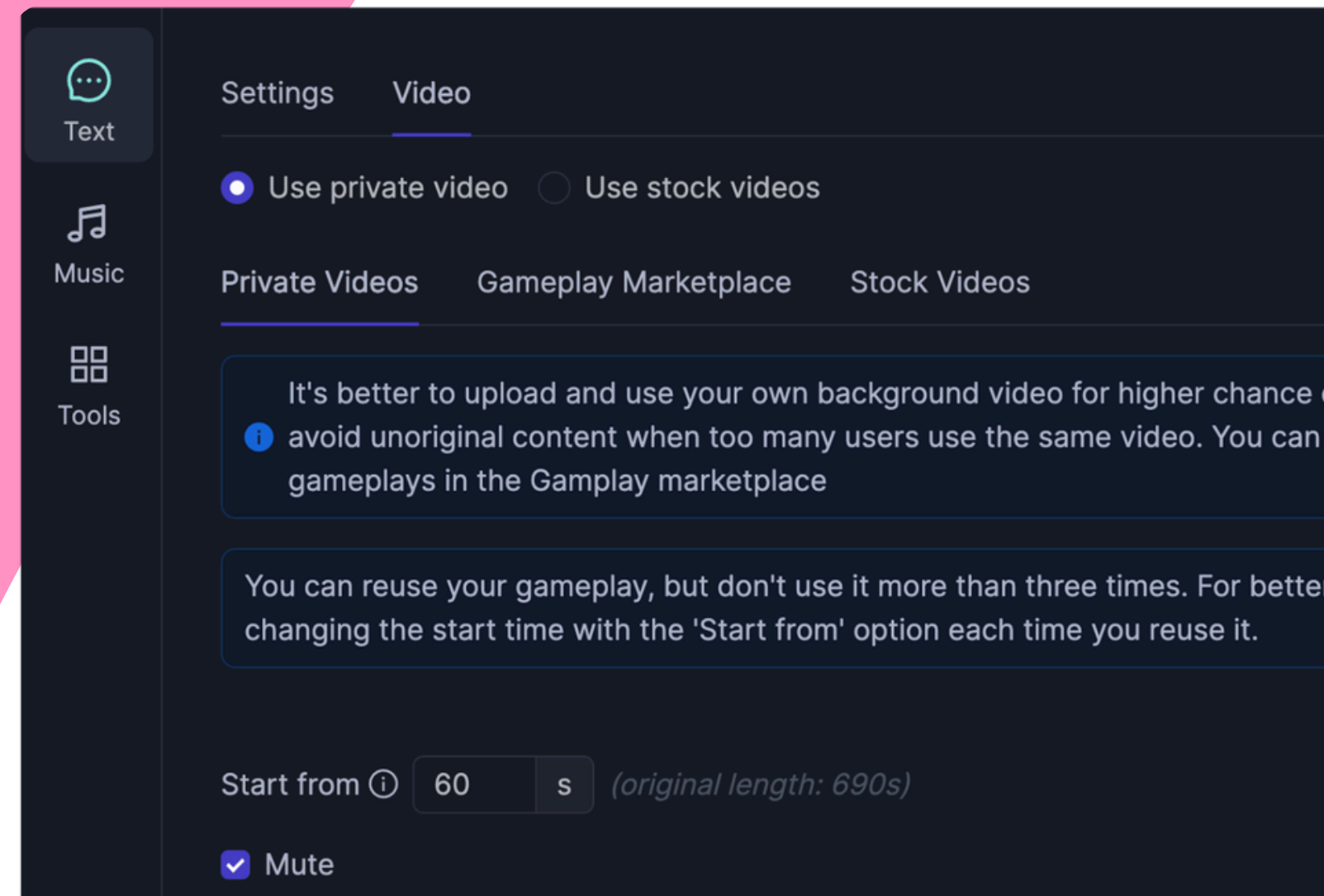
3. CUSTOMIZE

VOICEOVER



Here you can **change the voice** for this specific message and **regenerate it** if you don't like it (remember, however, that regenerating will cost additional credits).

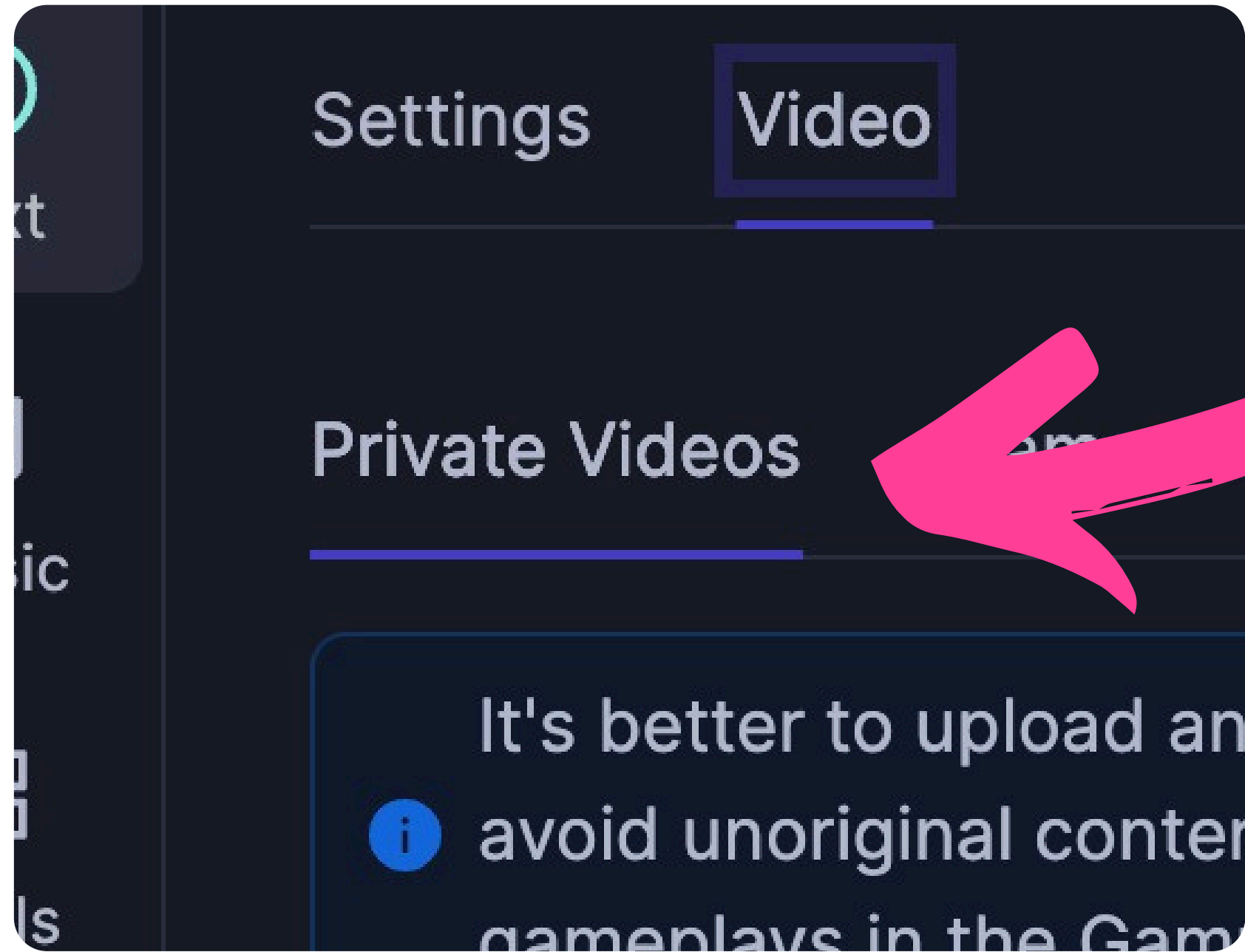




4. VIDEO

In this section, we choose the background for our video. We have 3 options: **Private Videos**, **Gameplay Marketplace**, **Stock Videos**

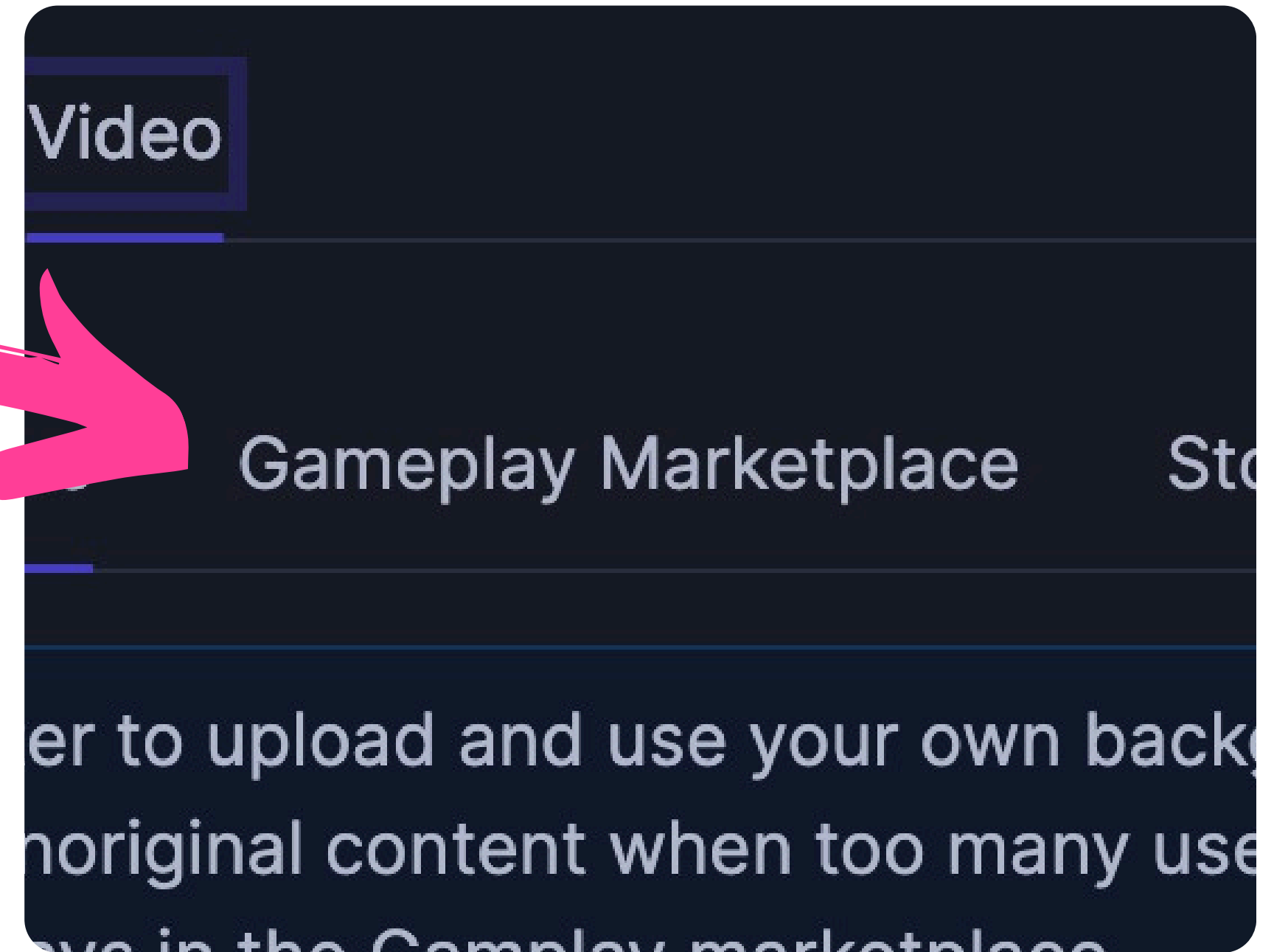
PRIVATE VIDEOS



In "**Private Videos**", we can choose our own backgrounds, which we can upload (*up to 10 custom backgrounds*).

GAMEPLAY MARKETPLACE

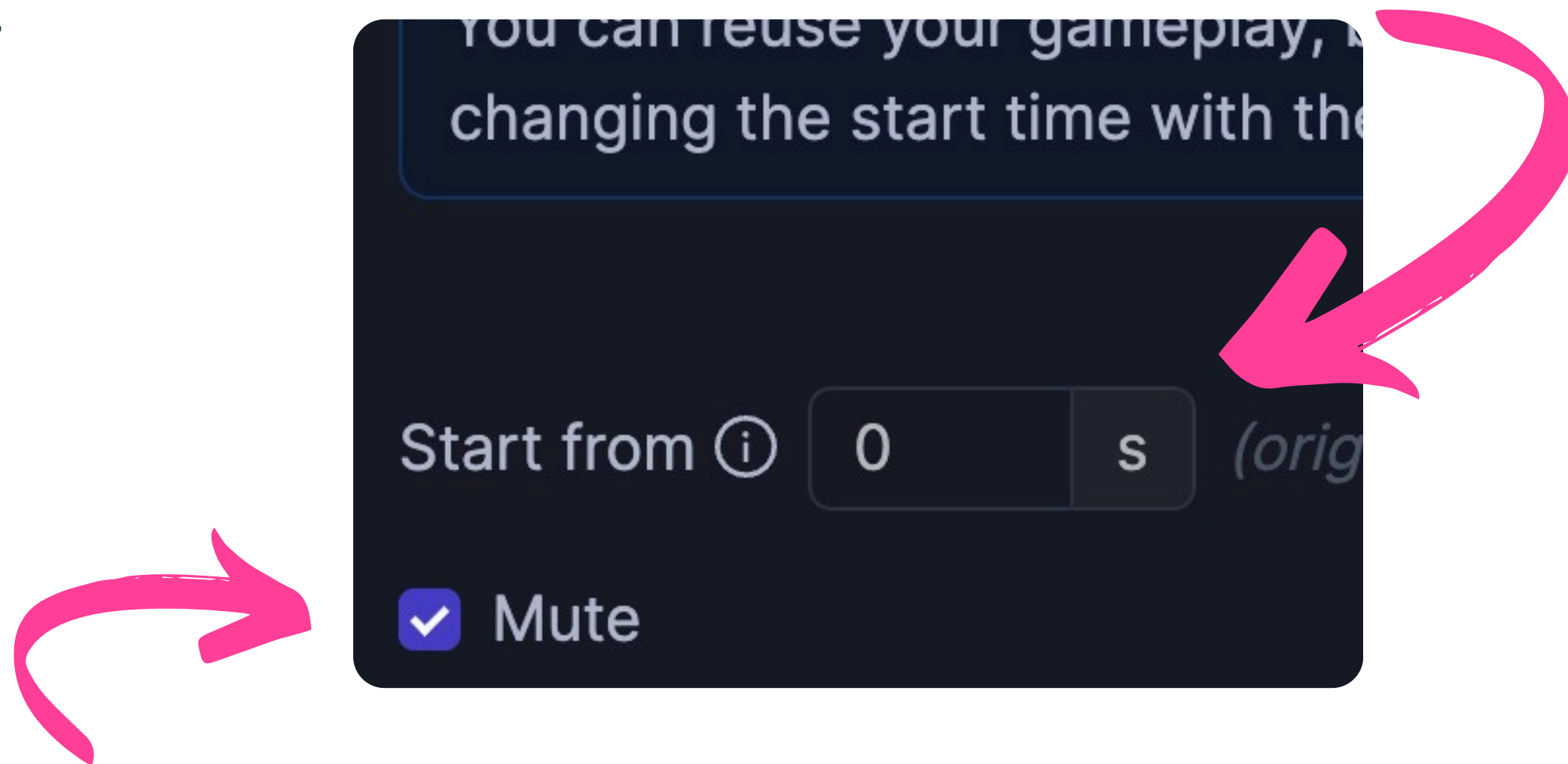
The custom gameplay marketplace, where we can **buy custom backgrounds for credits.**



4. VIDEO

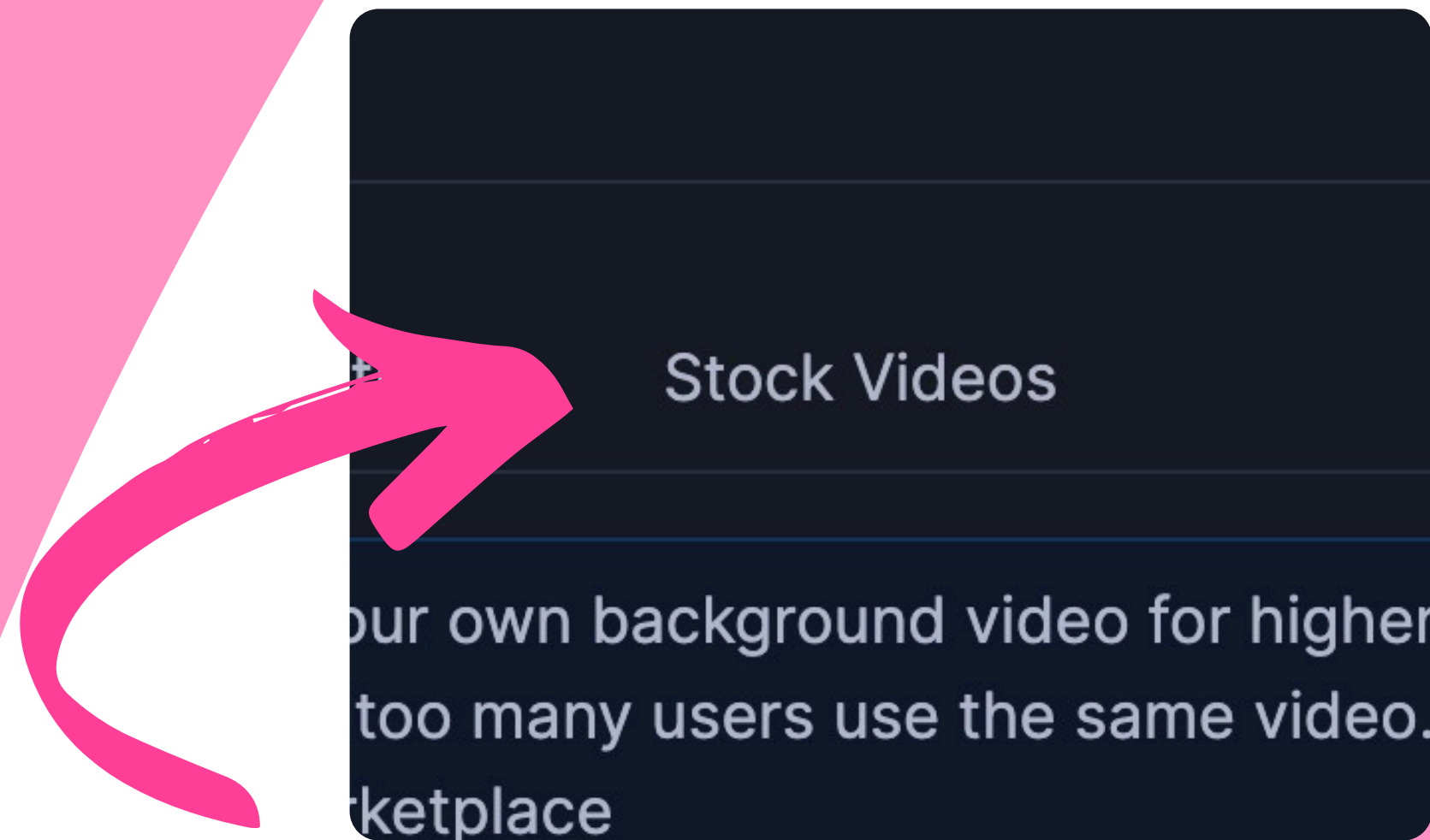
GAMEPLAY MARKETPLACE

We suggest using **your own background**, or **buying a custom one** and not using it too often. If you do use it, always start from a different point ("start from").



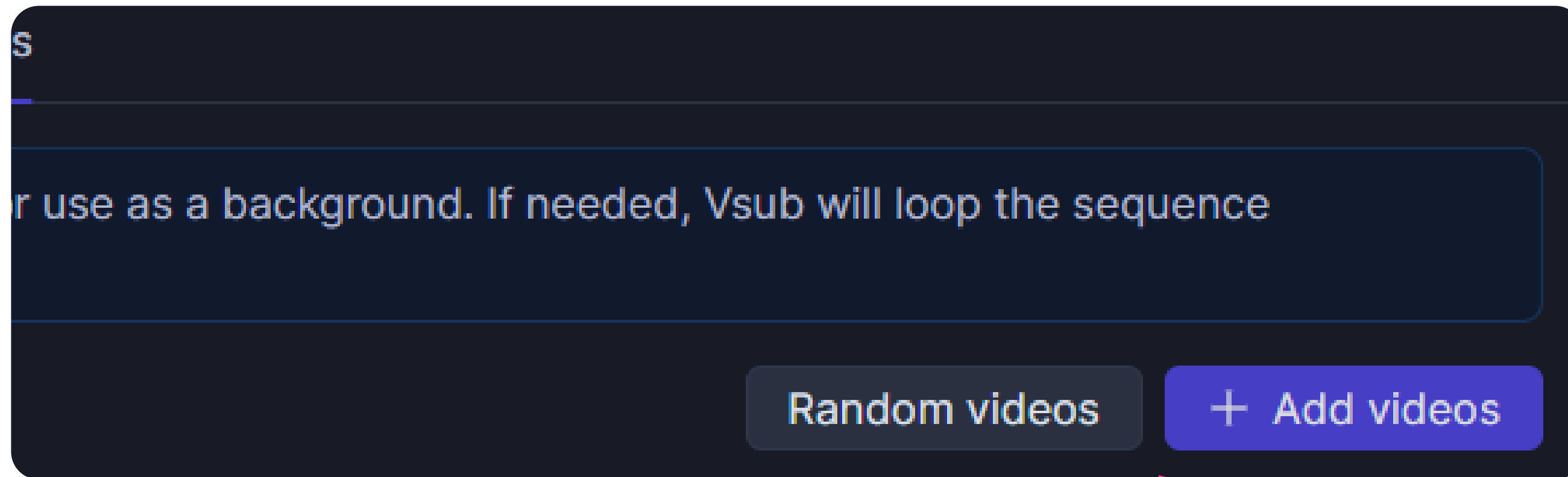
There is also an option to **mute the background sound**

STOCK VIDEOS



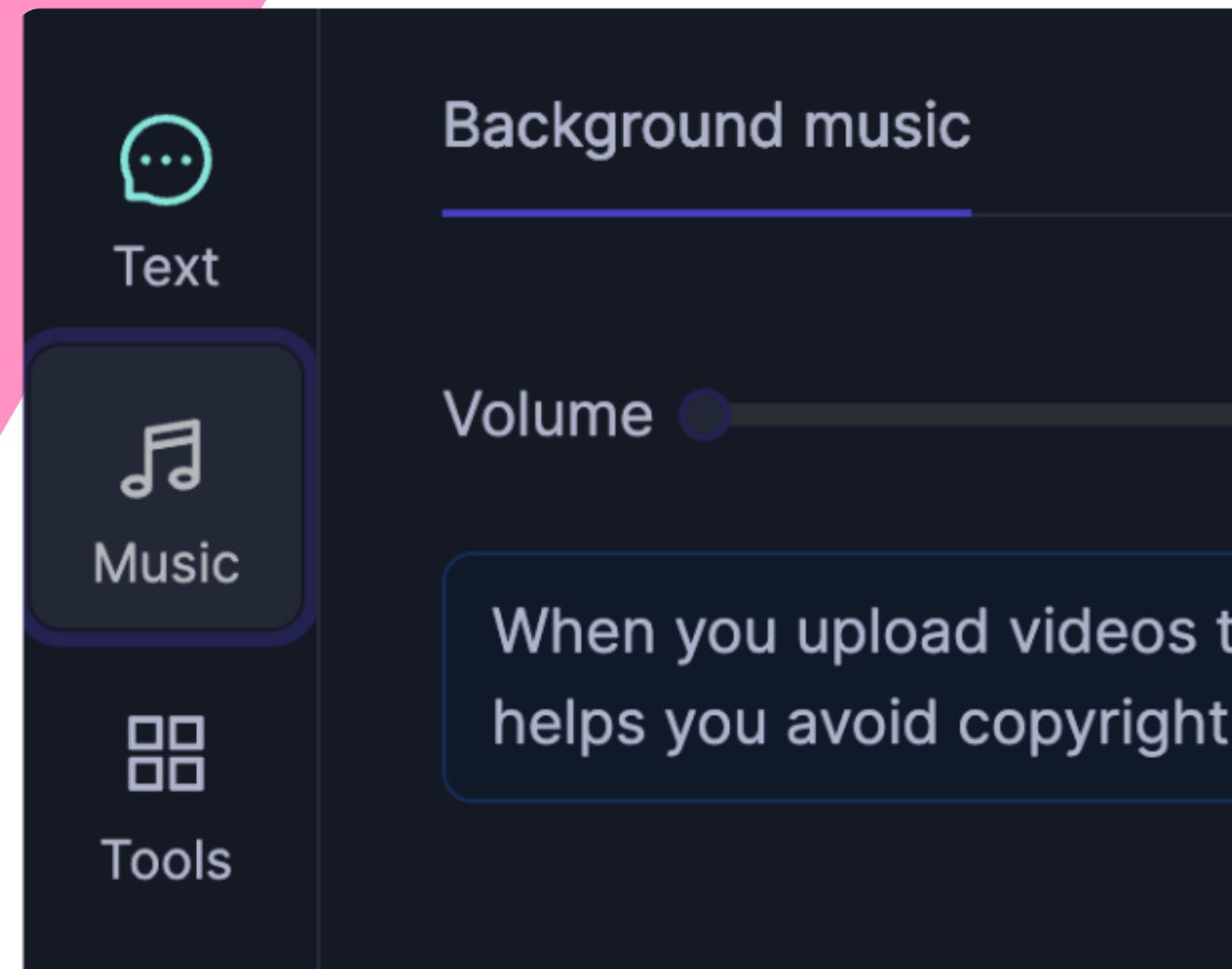
In this section, you can choose **stock videos** as the background.

STOCK VIDEOS



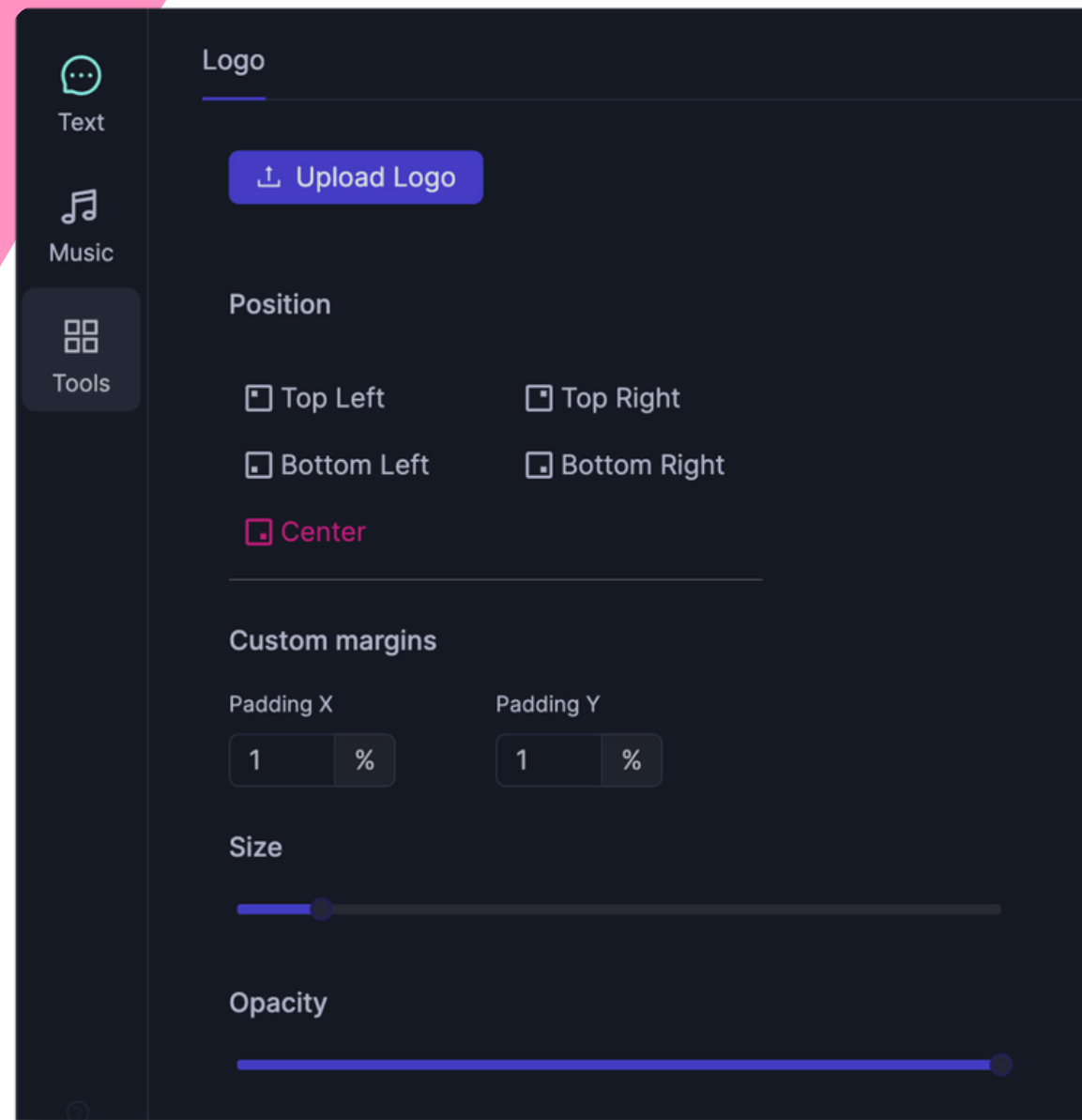
You have **two options**:

1. **Random videos:** you just need to enter a keyword, and related videos will be added.
2. **Add videos:** You also enter a keyword, but you select the specific videos you want to add.



5. MUSIC

In this section, you can add **background music** and **adjust its volume**, but we recommend adding music directly in the application (YT or TT).



6. TOOLS

In the tools section, you can **upload your logo** and customize it (e.g., use it as a watermark).

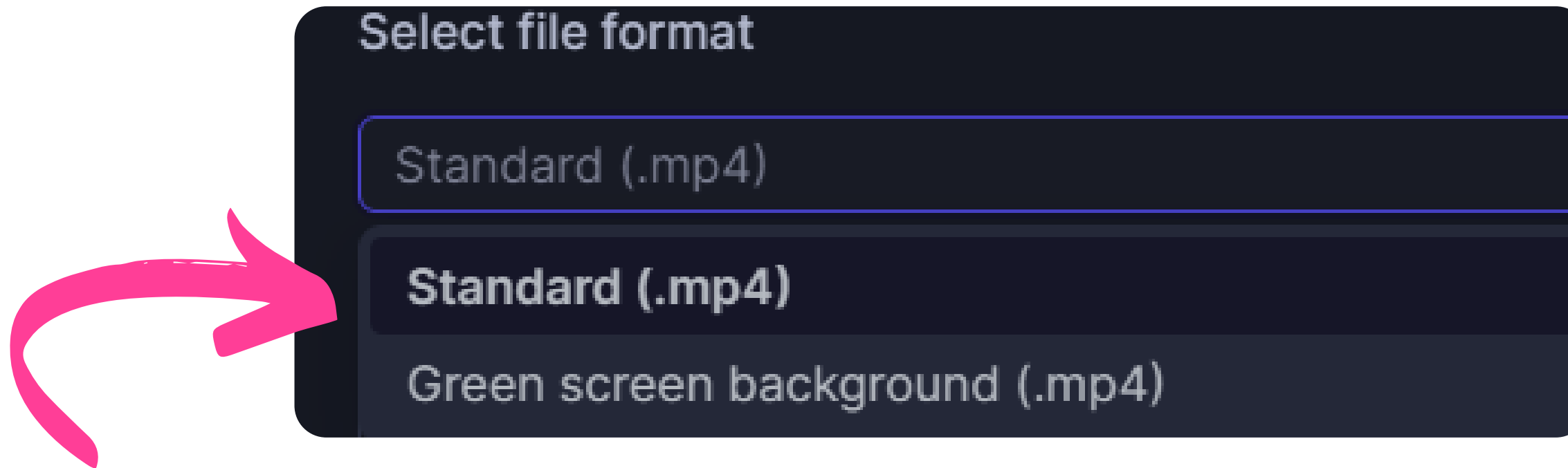

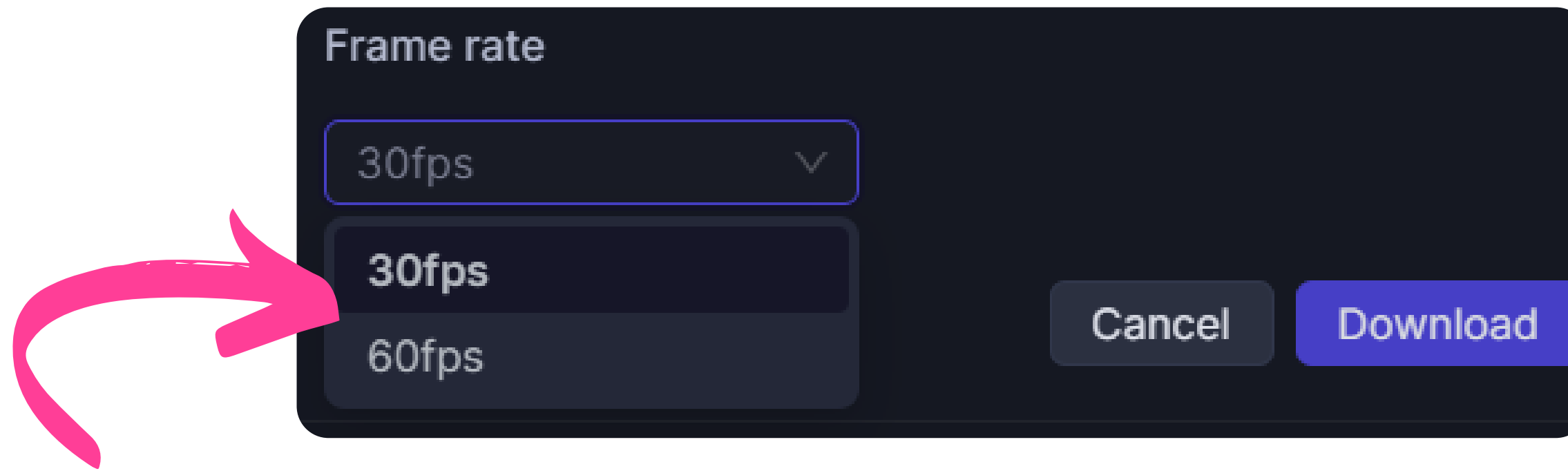
The final step is **downloading the video**. Remember that the background quality will always **be lower in the preview** than after downloading.



At this point, you have two download options: "**standard**," which includes the background you uploaded/selected earlier in the "Video" section, or "**Green screen background**," which has a solid color background that you can remove in editing programs like CapCut or Premiere Pro, and then add your own background.

The last option you need to choose is the "**frame rate**," which is a choice between 30 fps and 60 fps. The 60 fps option costs **more credits**.

For example, if we have 60 fps, it means that 60 frames will be displayed every second. The higher the FPS, the smoother and more realistic the video appears.
