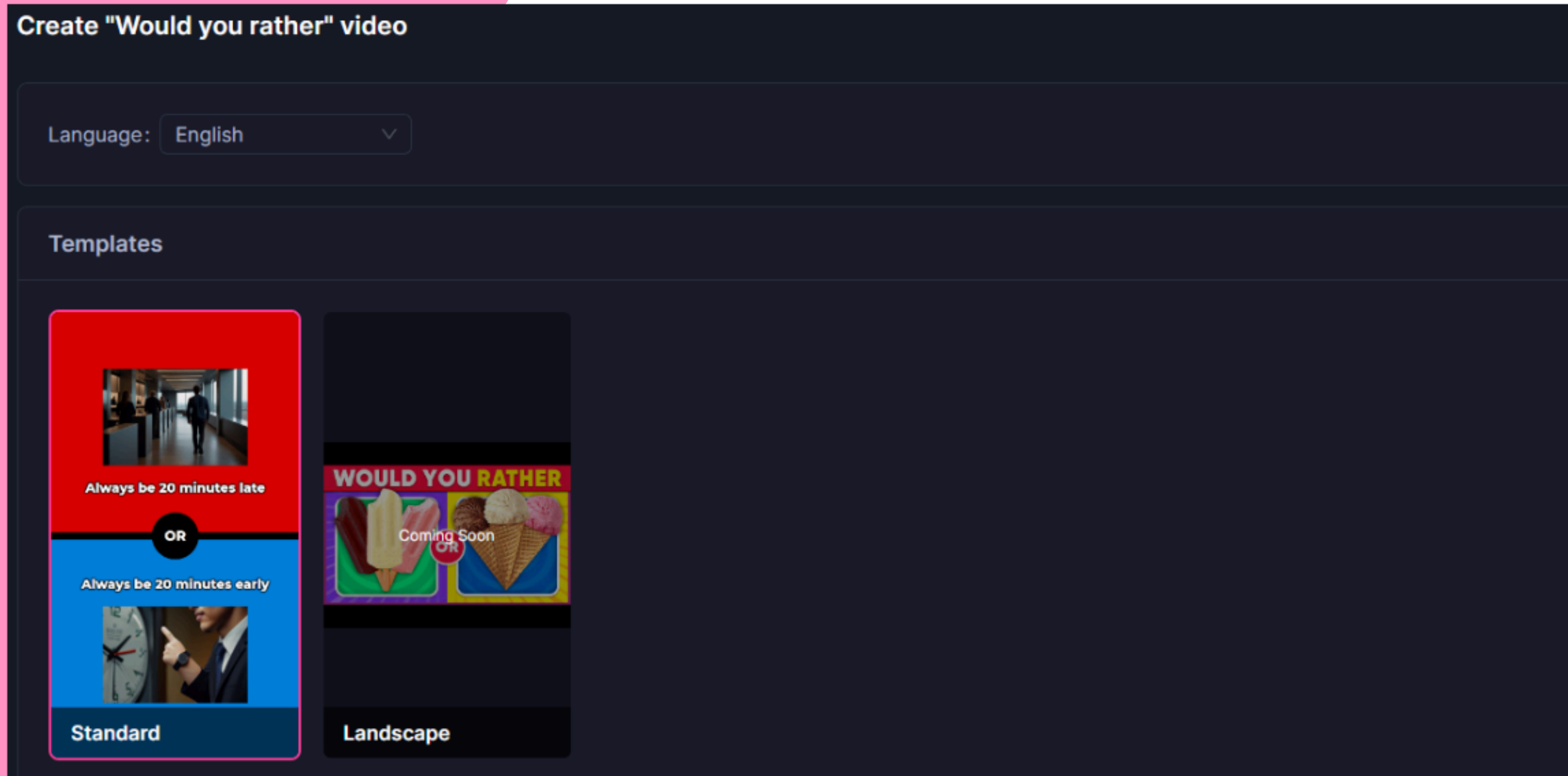
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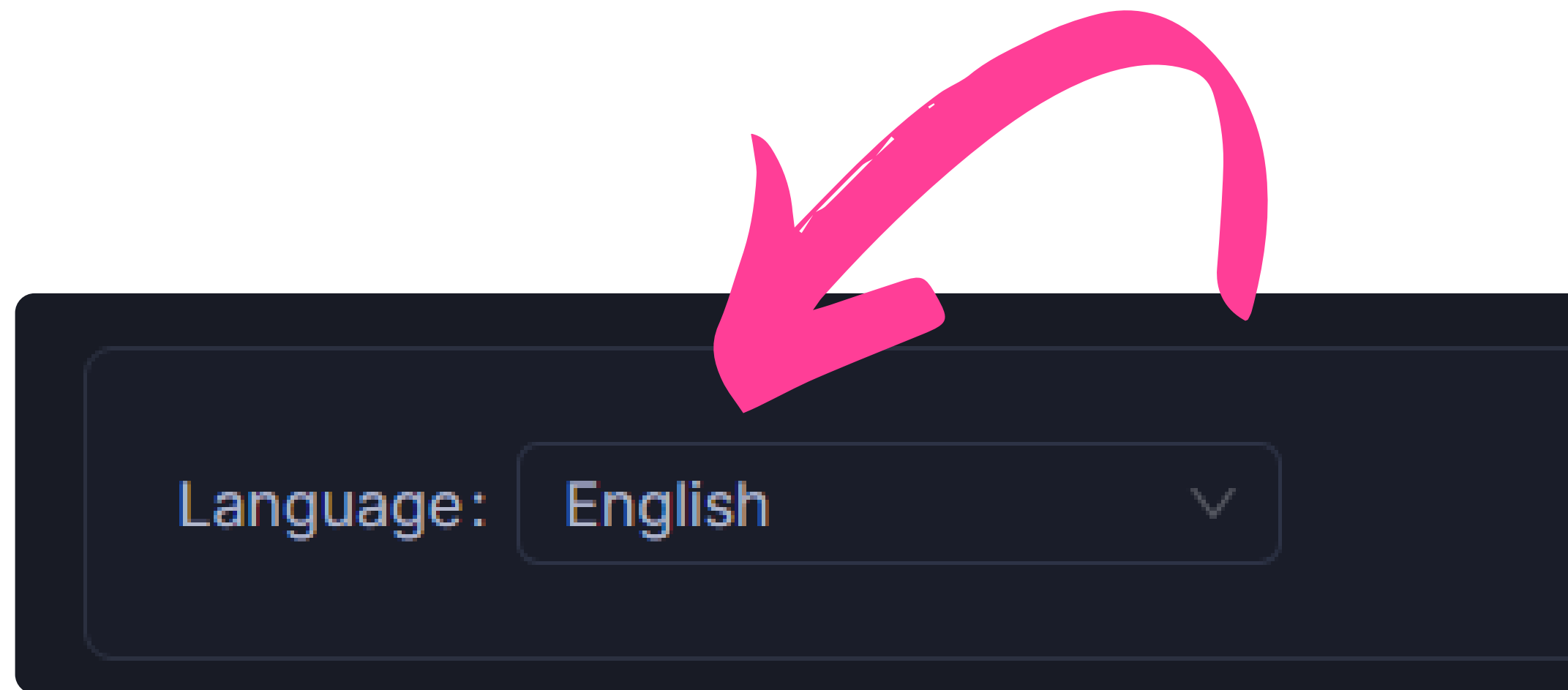

LANGUAGE

At the very beginning, you choose **the language** of your video. You can select from 28 languages.

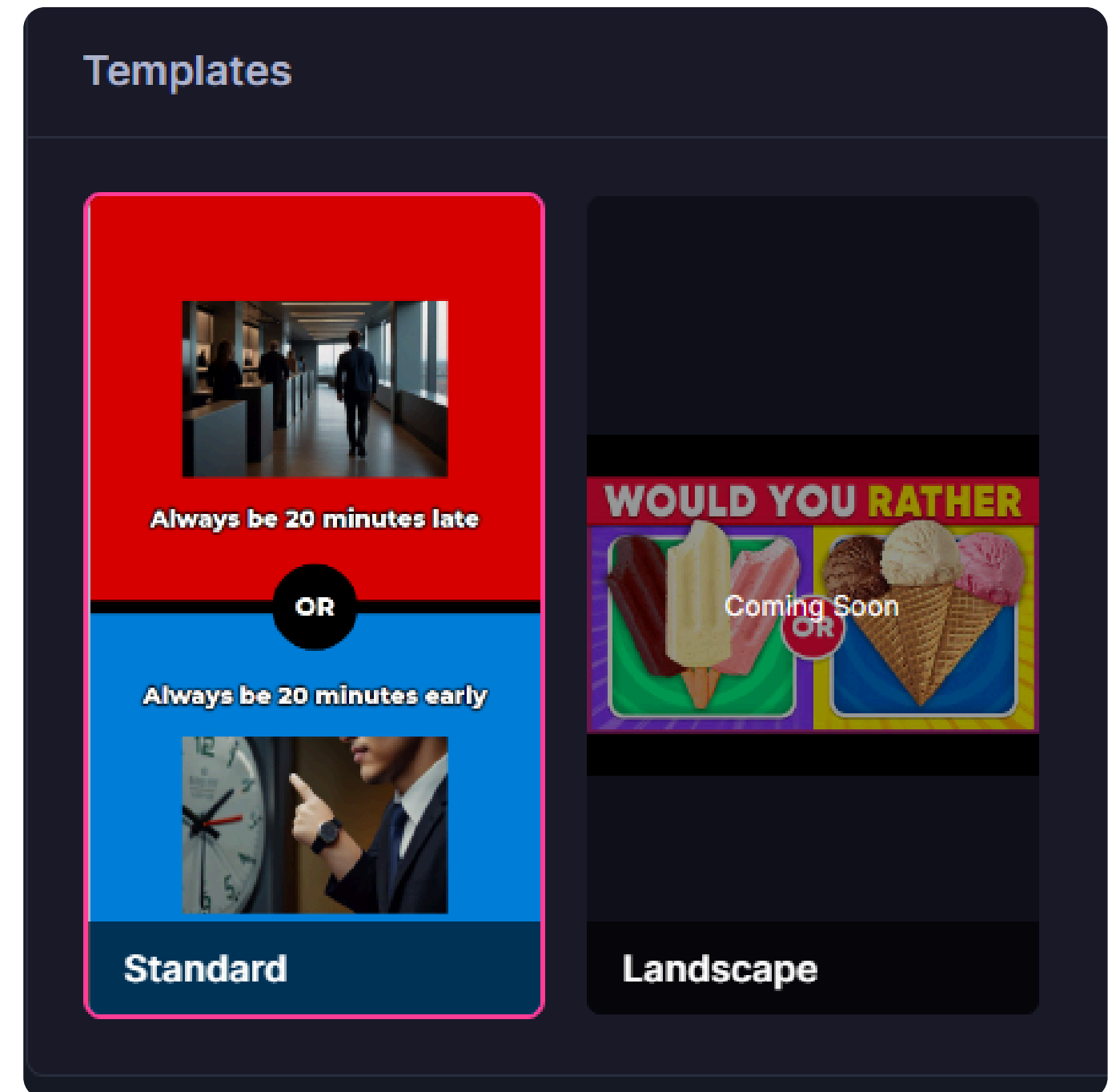

TEMPLATE

Here, you choose **the template** for your video.

Currently, the only available format is **Standard (9:16)**, but in the future, landscape (16:9) will also be available.

Now let's move on to the most important part, which is **the Questions**.

QUESTIONS

We have 3 options for adding questions:

The 'Import' button allows you to import your questions. The format can be a CSV file or CSV text. Here is an example of how to create the table:

A is the option that appears at the top, B is the option that appears at the bottom, and A% is the percentage of people who voted for option A.

QUESTIONS

Now let's discuss the options for editing questions.

You can use this button to **change the order** of the questions.

In this section, if your **'Type'** is **'Questions,'** you enter option 'A,' which appears at the top of the video. **If you selected 'Type' as 'Comment,'** you enter your comment here.

Here, you enter the **percentage of people who voted for option 'A.'** If you don't enter anything, this percentage will be generated randomly.

Here you can choose the type of text: either **'Question,'** which is an A or B question, or **'Comment,'** which is a separate verbal comment made by the narrator, such as a CTA or a remark on the question.

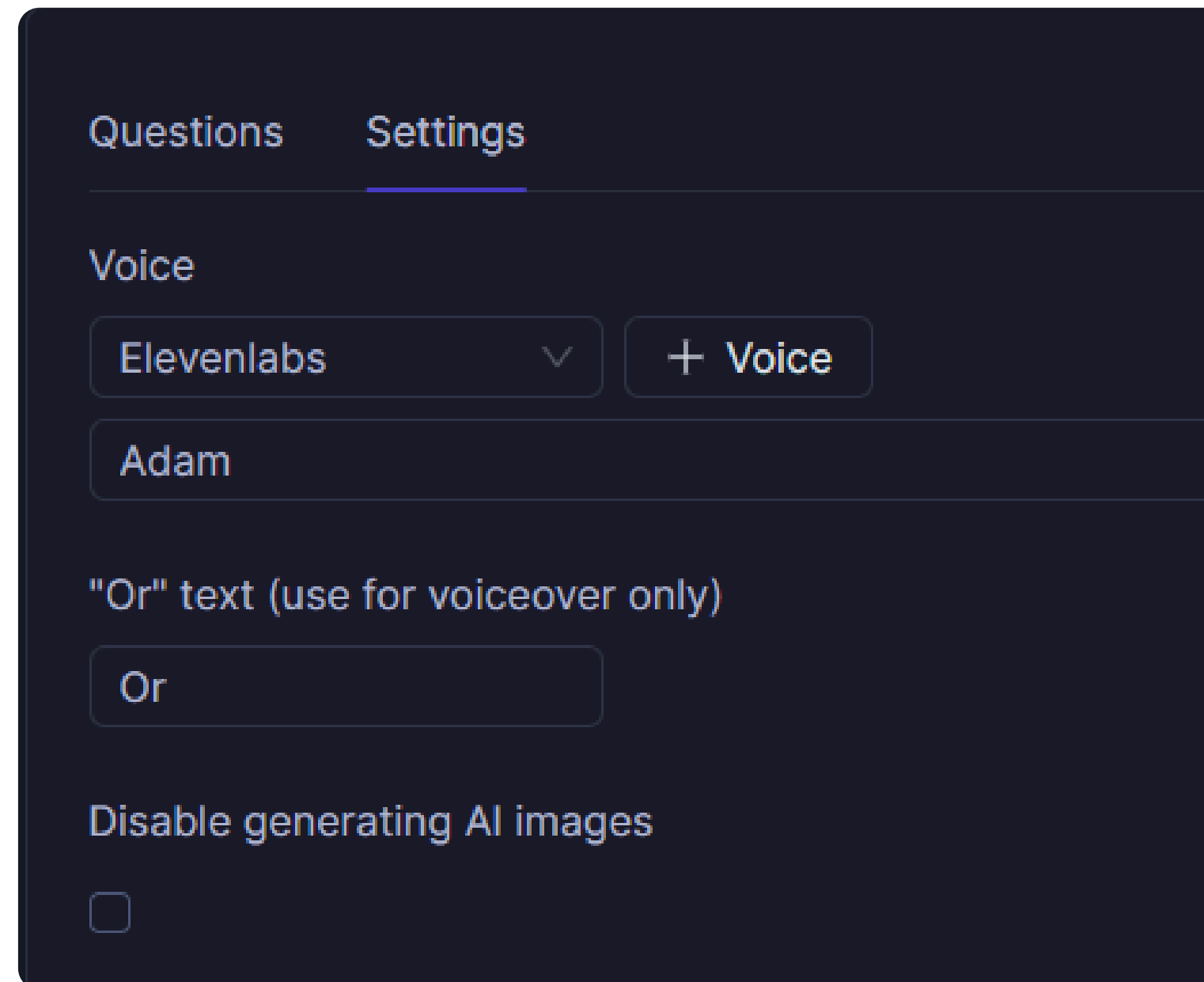
And here, you simply **enter option 'B,'** which appears at the bottom of the video.

Here you can **choose your voiceover** from three options: *Elevenlabs*, *OpenAI*, and *Amazon Polly*.

Here you decide **whether AI should generate images for each option** or if you want to add them yourself in the next step.

In this section, you can **add a voice from Elevenlabs that isn't on the list**. Just add it to your library, copy its link, and paste it here.

In the 'Or text' section, **you enter the text that your voiceover will read as 'Or'** – in most cases, you leave it as it is. 'Or' is the word read between option 'A' and option 'B.'

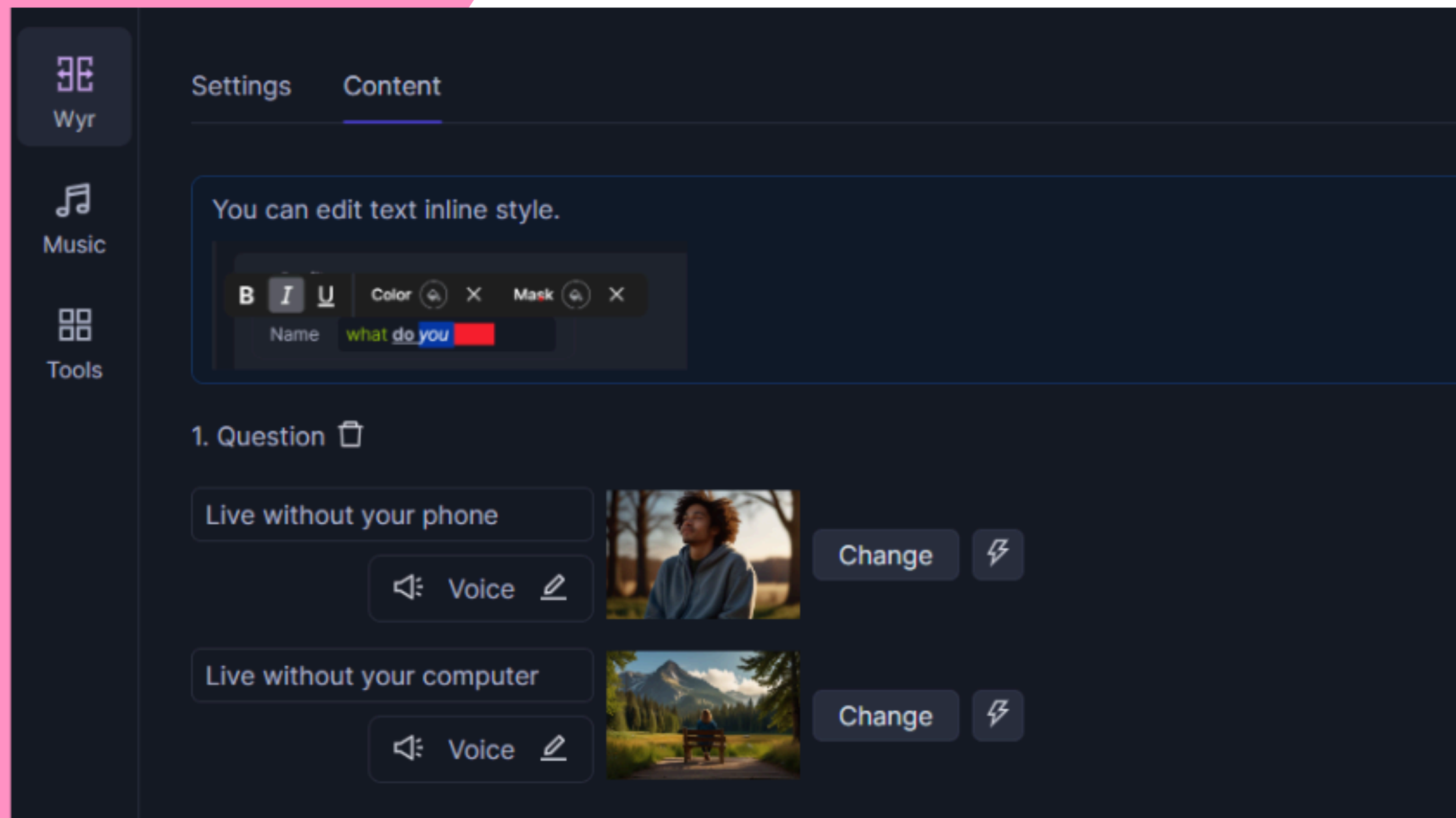

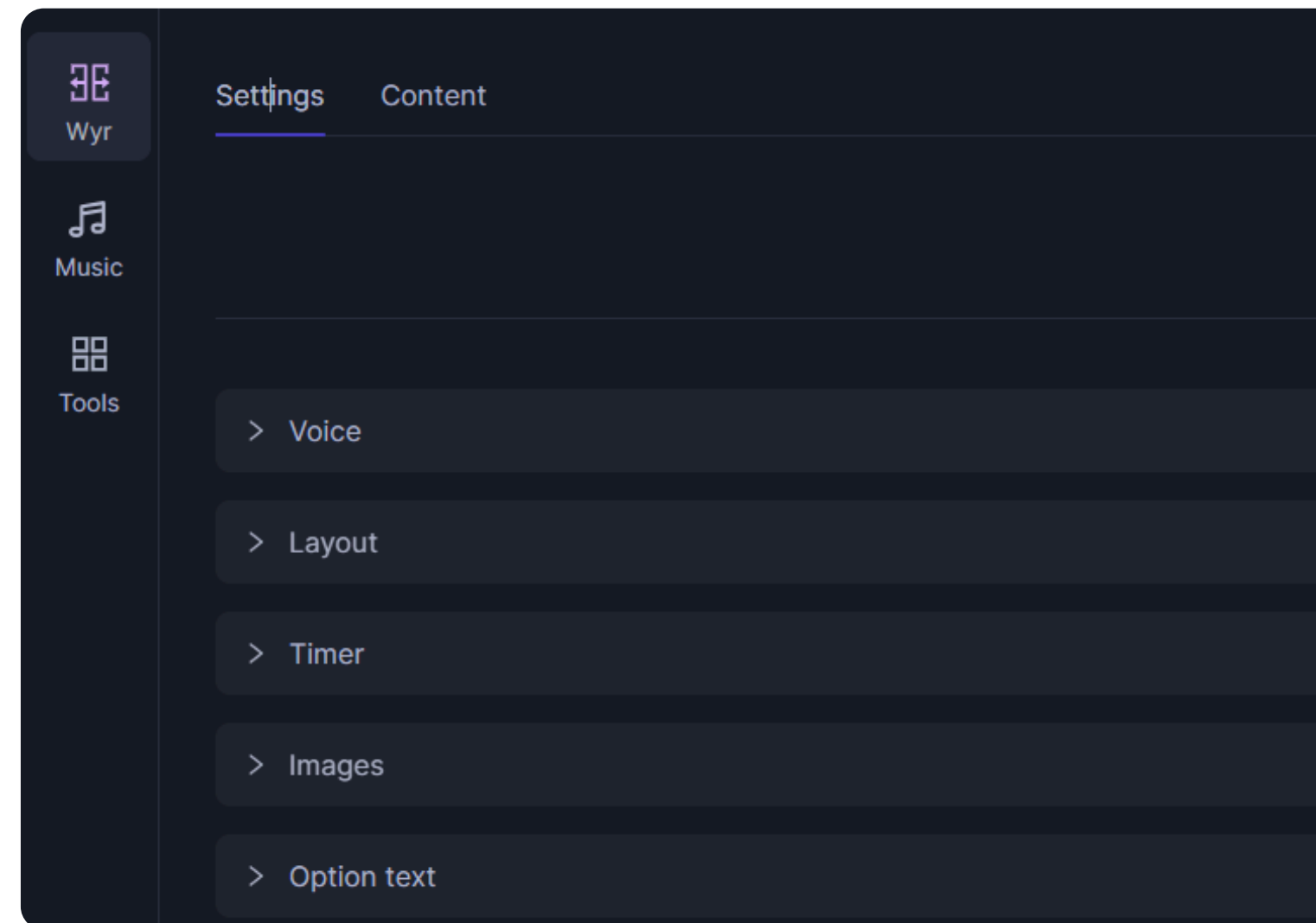

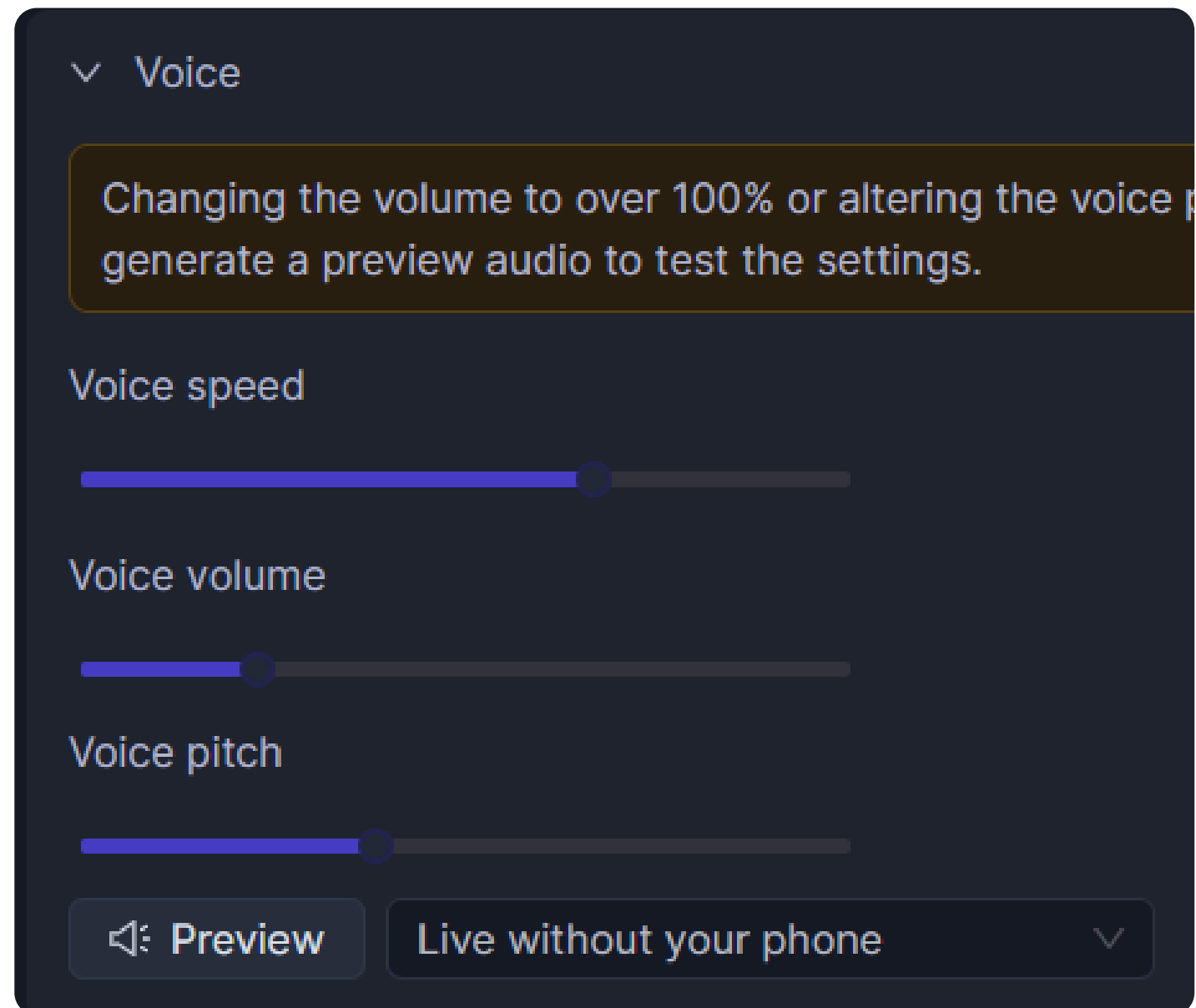

The first tab we'll go through is **the Settings**. Here, we can further customize our video.

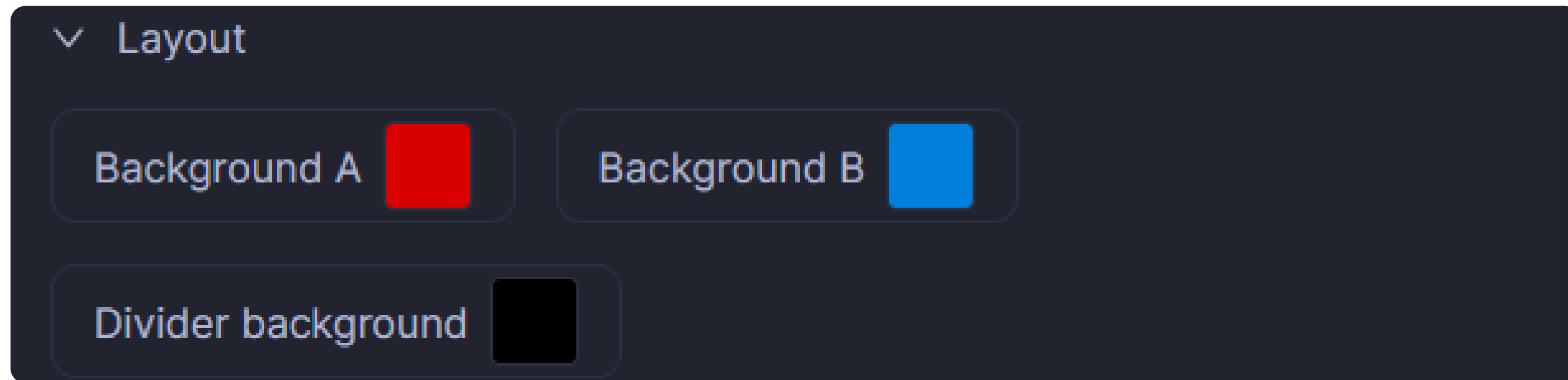


Moving on to the first category, called '**Voice**,' here we have three options to adjust:

- '**Voice Speed**' - increasing/decreasing the speed of your narrator's voice
- '**Voice Volume**' - increasing/decreasing the volume of your narrator's voice
- '**Voice Pitch**' - adjusting the pitch of your narrator's voice

In the '**Preview**' you can hear the changes you've made. Just remember that changing the volume to over 100% or altering the voice pitch will only be applied during rendering

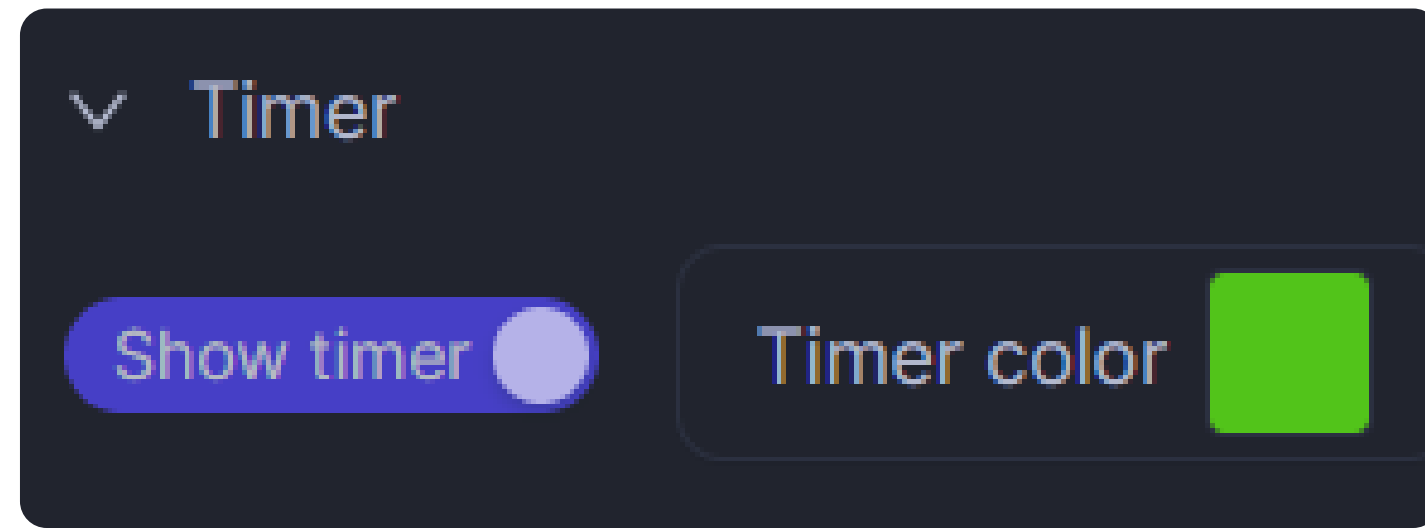

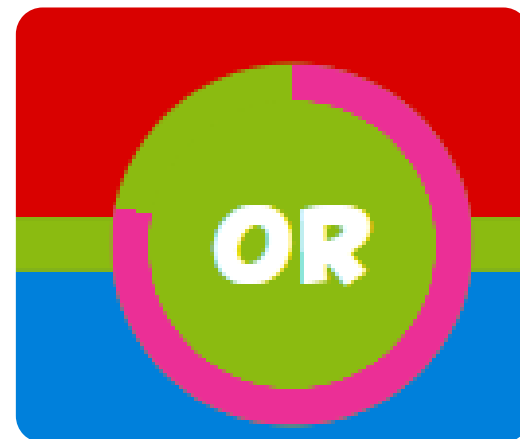
In the 'Layout' category, you choose the colors for your background.

The first color is for the top background, the second color is for the bottom background, and the third color is for the background dividing the two (the strip with the word 'Or').

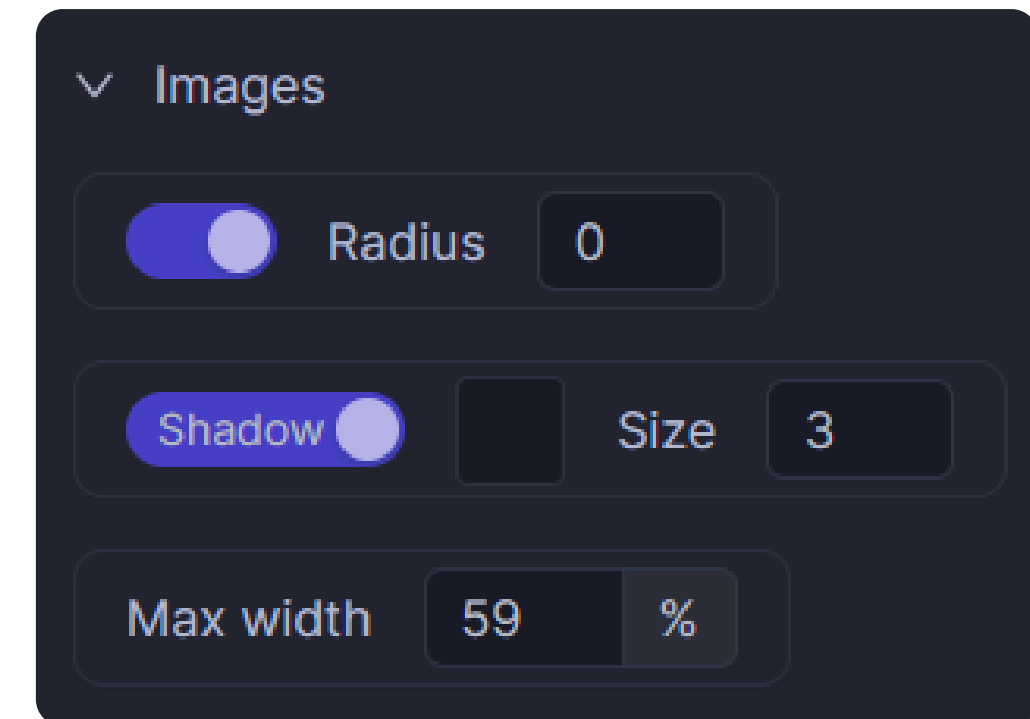

In the 'Timer' section, you decide whether you want it to be displayed on the video and what color it should be.



In the 'Images' section, you set whether you want images for each option to be displayed, and you can further customize them by adjusting the size, rounding, and shadow options.

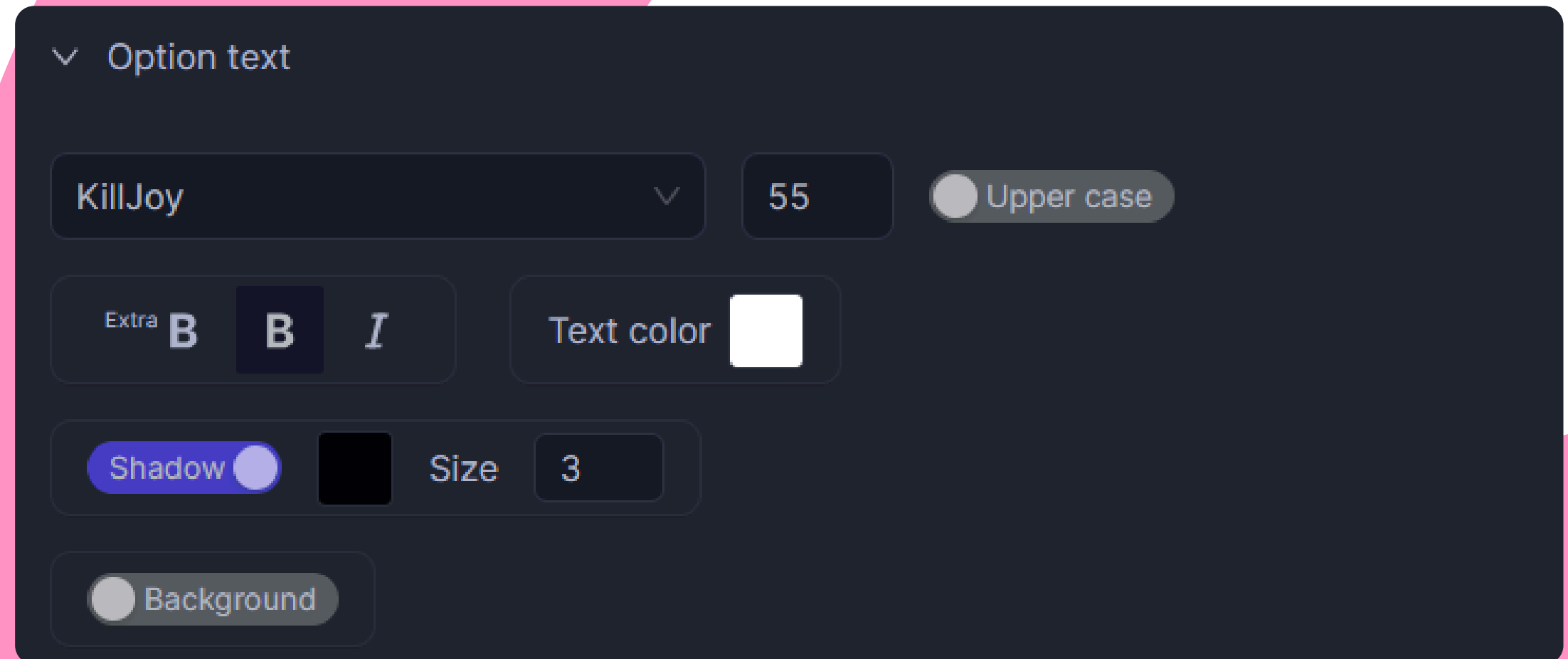

SETTINGS

In the 'Option Text' section, you customize the appearance of the text in both options (Option A and Option B).

Here, you set the font, text size, whether it should be uppercase, its color, and if it should have a shadow and background (both of these options can be further customized after selection).

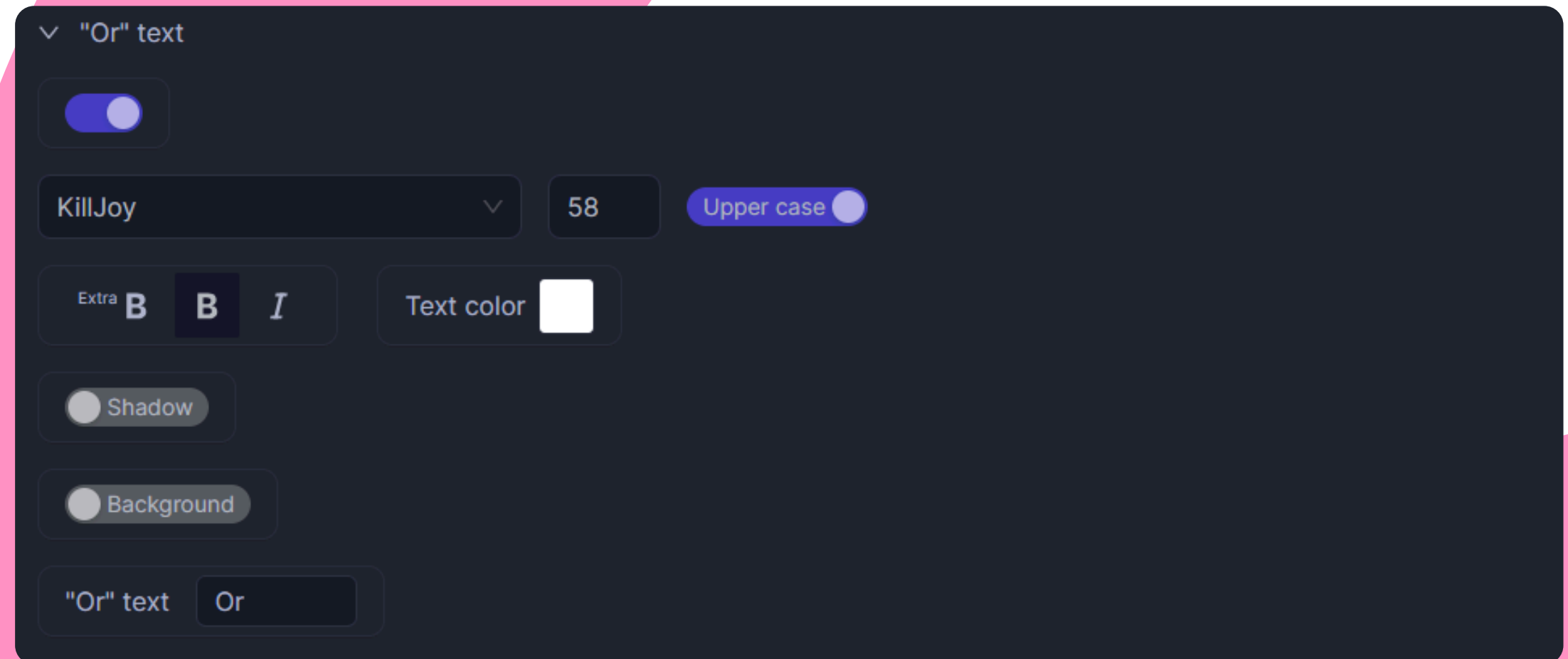

In the 'Result Text' section, you have the same options as in “Option Text”, with one exception: **here, you can also choose a different color for Result A and Result B.**

In the 'Or Text' section, you have the same options as in 'Option Text.' Additionally, **you can edit the word that appears in place of 'Or.'**

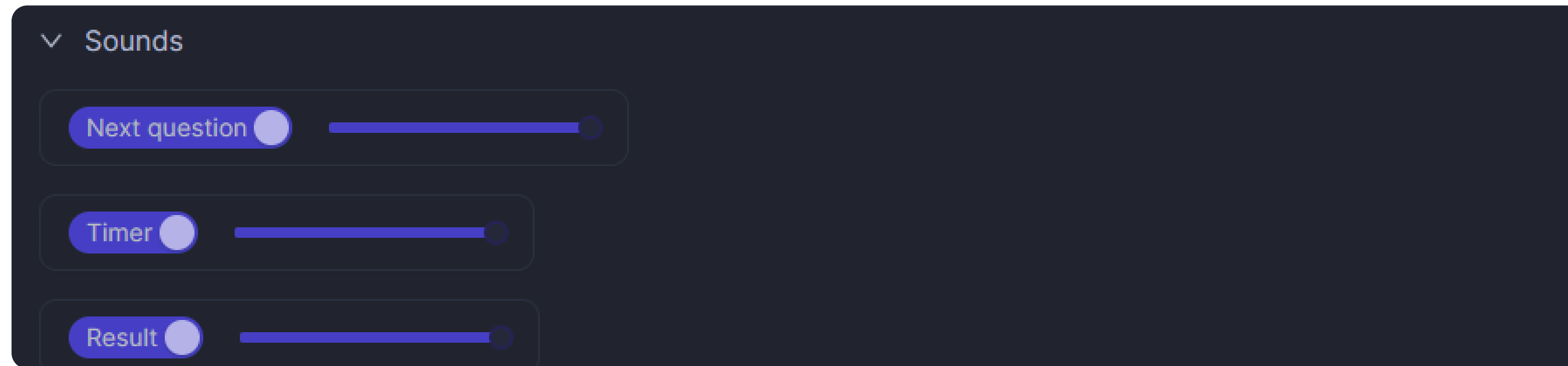

In the 'Comments' section, you again have the same options as in 'Option Text.' This changes the appearance of the text that **we previously set as 'Comment,'** rather than 'Question.'

In the last category of Settings, called '**Sounds**,' we set three sound effects. Each of them can be turned off and their volume adjusted.

- '**Next question**' is the sound that plays when transitioning from the end of one question to the beginning of the next.
- '**Timer**' is the sound that plays while counting down the time to answer.
- '**Result**' is the sound that plays when showing the results after the timer.

Now we move on to the next tab, which is '**Content**.'

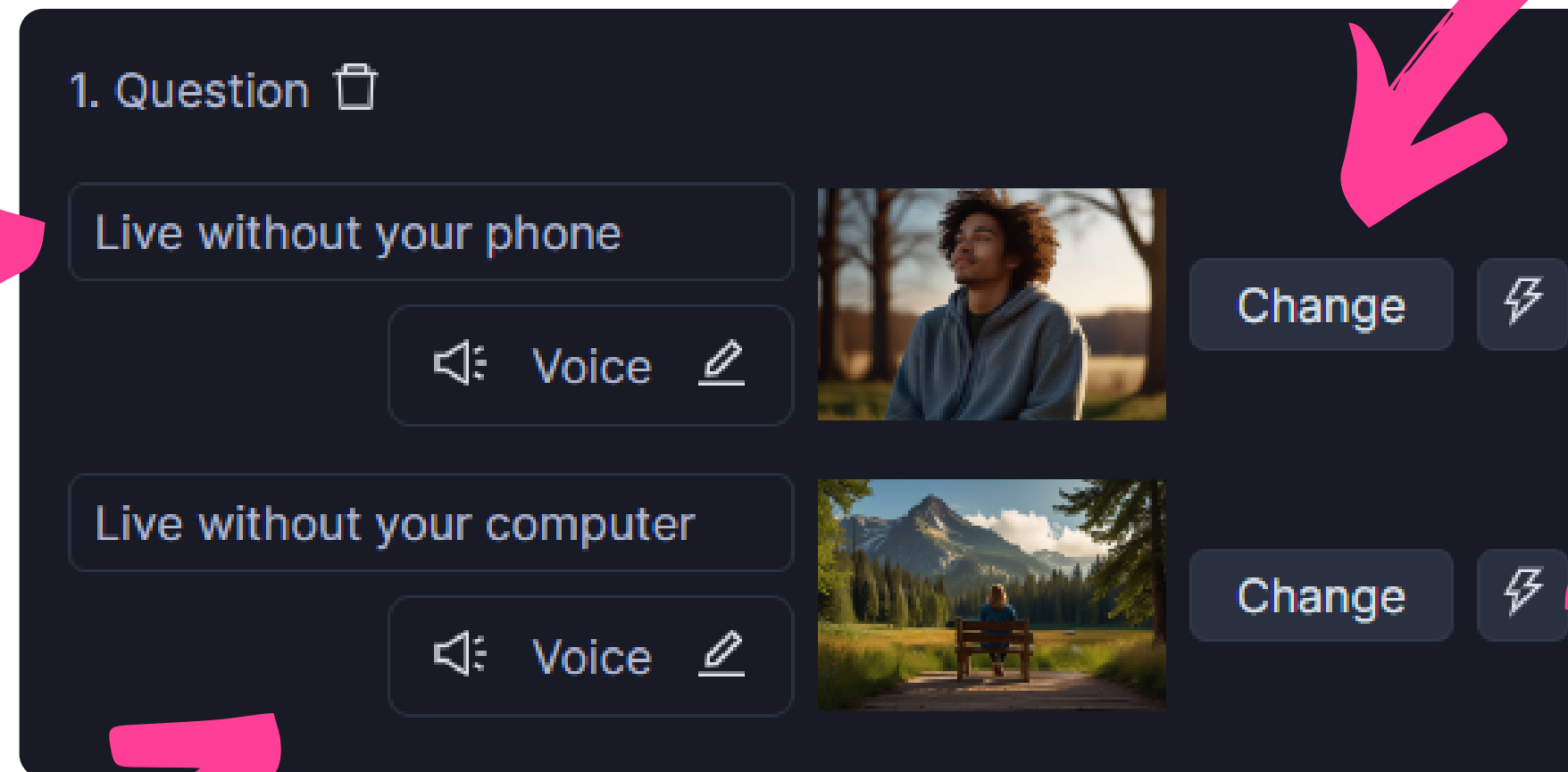

CONTENT

In this section, you can **edit and customize** each of your questions.

Here you can **edit the text of your options** (Option 'A' and below, Option 'B').

In **'Voice,'** you can **change the narrator's voice** for each of your options or **regenerate** the spoken options if you don't like the tone.

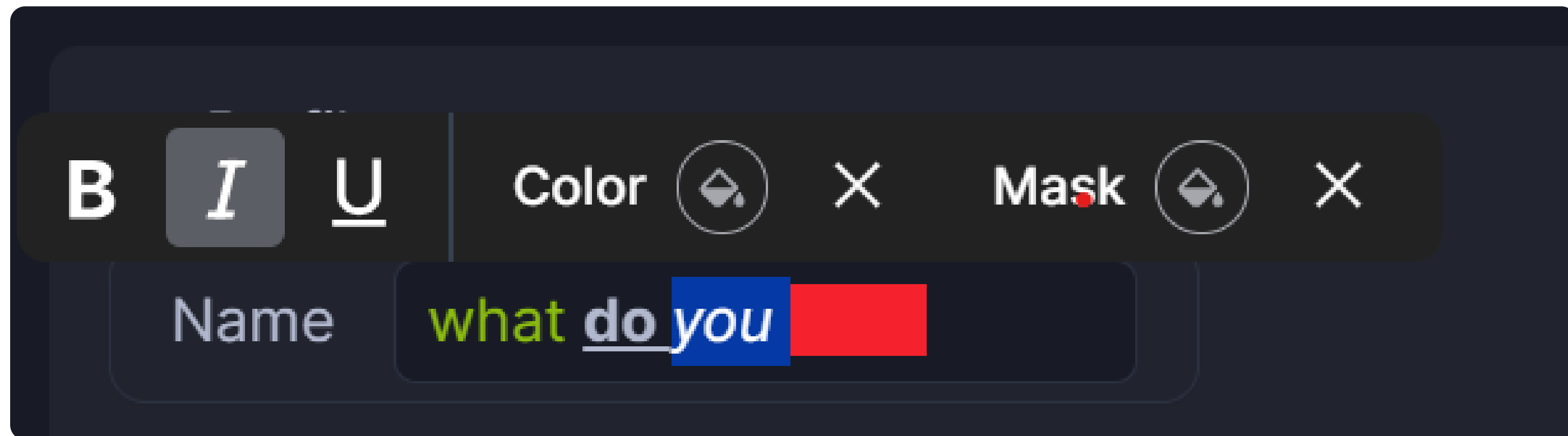


In **'Change,'** you **upload your own image** for your option 'A' or 'B' (you can also paste a link to it).

This little lightning bolt allows you to **generate an AI image for your option** (you can also manage the prompt yourself).

CONTENT

In **Content section**, you can also edit the text style of your options (e.g., completely mask a word using the 'Mask' option).

When you upload videos to TikTok, it's best to add background music to avoid any problems.

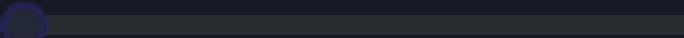

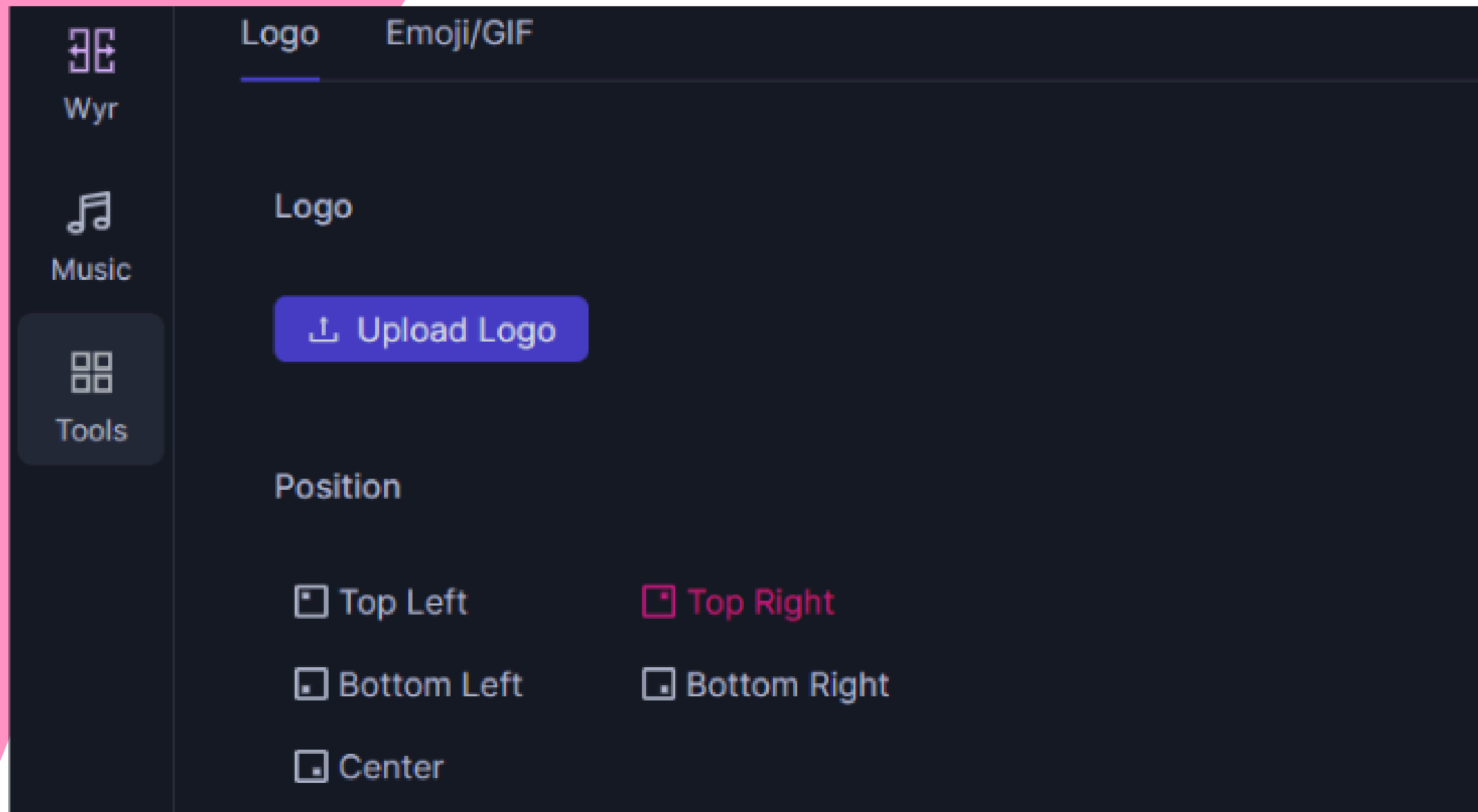
In this section, you can **add background music and adjust its volume**, but we recommend adding music directly in the application (YT or TT).

When you upload videos to TikTok, it's best to add background music from TikTok's library. This helps you avoid copyright problems.



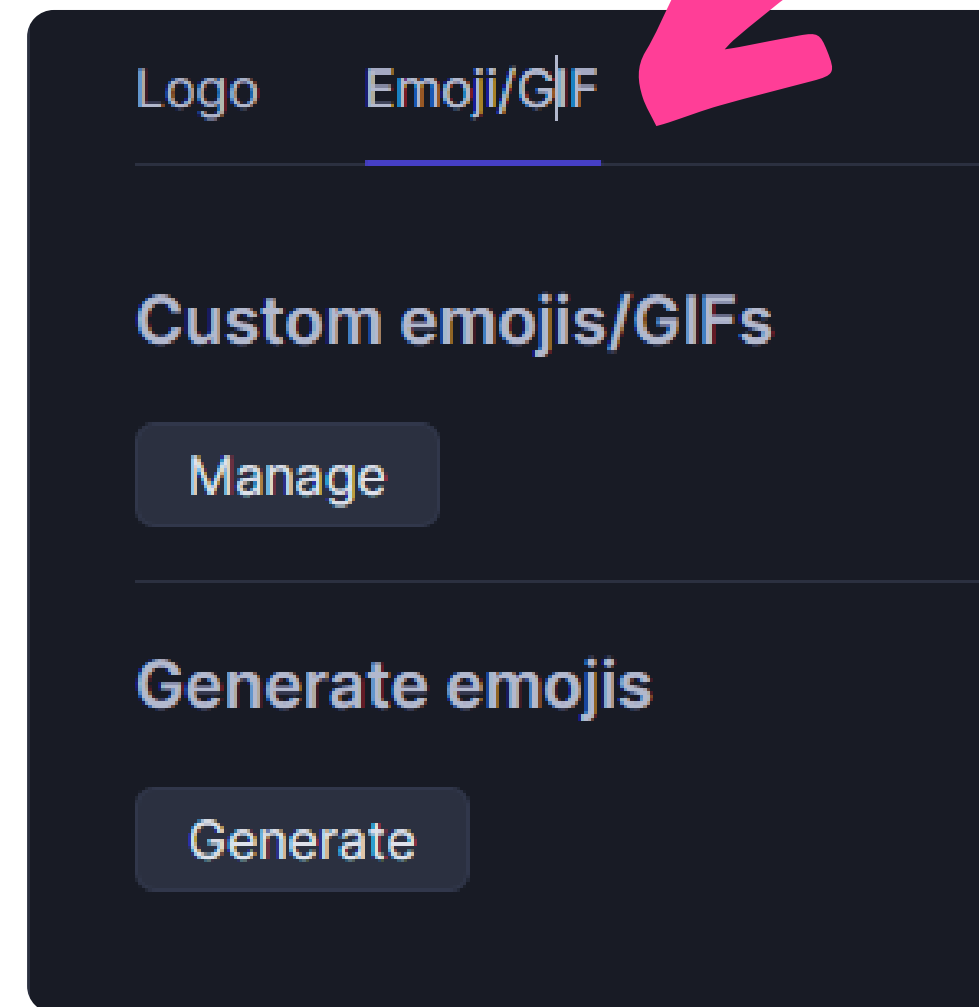
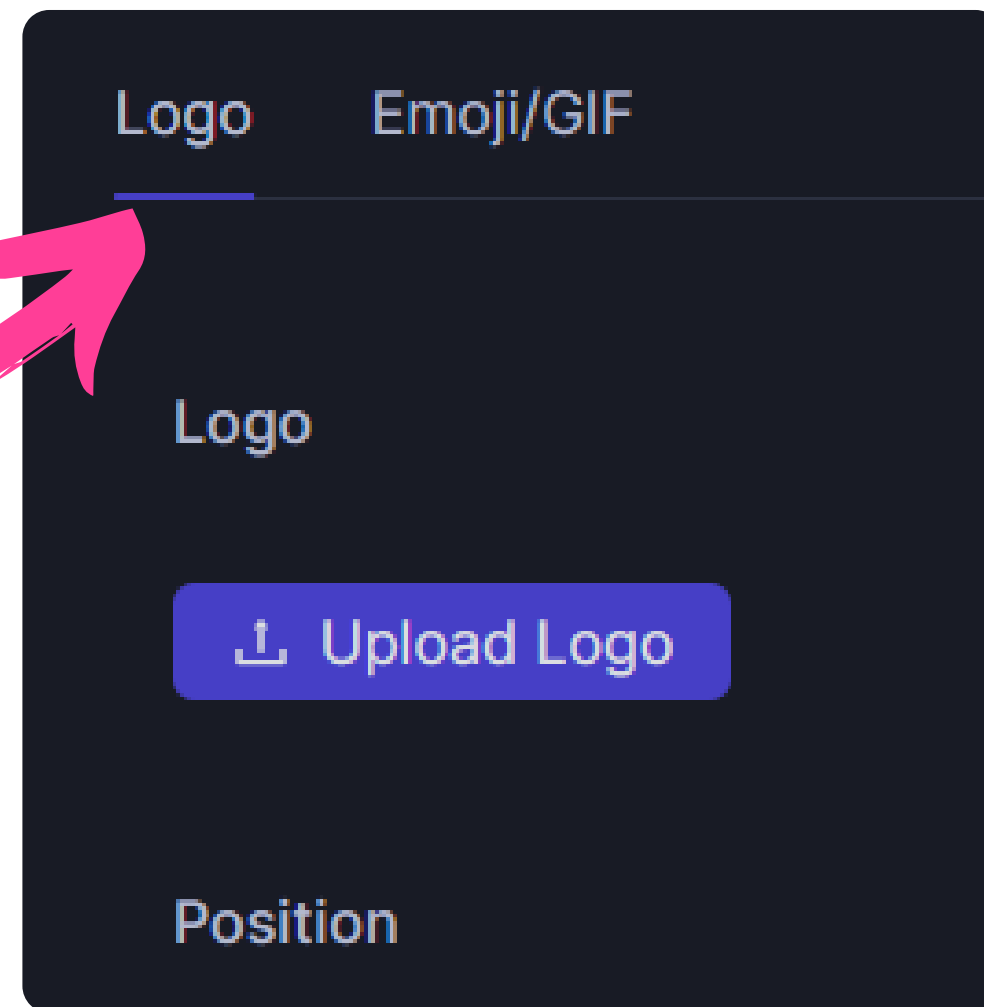
